Dear Mr. Mansfield:

On December 4, 2002, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. After considering the information in the complaint, and information provided by you and other respondents, the Commission found on August 27, 2004, that there is no reason to believe either you or Alumni for O'Grady violated 2 U.S.C. § 441d(a)(1). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter as it pertains to you and Alumni for O'Grady.

The Act requires that while the case is open as to other respondents, the confidentiality provisions of 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(12)(A) remain in effect. The Commission will notify you when the entire file has been closed.
