On January 24, 2003, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients, the Democratic Congressional Campaign Committee and Howard Wolfson, as treasurer (the current treasurer, now named as respondent, is James J. Bonham), of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On June 8, 2004, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint and information submitted in response, that there is no reason to believe your clients violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441a(a)(2)(A), 441a(d)(3), or 441a(f). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). A copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.
