
On March 3, 2003, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On June 24, 2004, the Commission determined to take no action with respect to allegations that you made excessive contributions, in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
