

Dear Mr. Jordan:

I am in receipt of your letter and enclosures notifying me of a complaint concerning campaign contributions made to the Runbeck for Congress campaign in 2000.

The complaint concerns contributions from two PACs, specifically Value in Electing Women PAC and New American Century. I personally met Rep. Pryce in September specifically to solicit support from VIEW PAC and that support was gratefully received.

My campaign, however, had no reason to believe much less any way of knowing, when the New American Century contribution arrived in November, that these two PACS were affiliated multi-candidate PACs and that the aggregated contributions would be considered to have exceeded the limits.

If indeed the Federal Elections Commission determines that the complaint has merit, the Runbeck for Congress campaign committee will return the excessive contribution in compliance with the law.

Please keep me abreast of the proceedings regarding this matter.
