On March 20, 2003, the Federal Election Commission notified your client, Abigail S. Wexner, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). On June 8, 2004, the Commission found, based on the information in the complaint and the information provided in the response there is no reason to believe that your client violated the Act as alleged in the complaint. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.
