Additional RTB Recommendation as to Gary Esporrin in First GCR

On Monday, September 8, 2003, the First General Counsel's Report in Pre-MUR 412 and MUR 5357 was transmitted to the Commission. The voting deadline is 4:00pm on Thursday September 11, 2003.

The narrative discussion as to Respondent Gary Esporrin on pp. 12-13 of the First GCR explicitly recommends Reason to Believe findings as to both 2 U.S.C. Section 441b and 2 U.S.C. Section 441f. In the Recommendations Section on p. 19, however, Recommendation #6 inadvertently omits the Section 441b Reason to Believe finding against Mr. Esporrin.

Accordingly, for the reasons already set forth in the First GCR at pp. 12-13, the Office of the General Counsel requests that the Commission find Reason to Believe that Gary Esporrin violated 2 U.S.C. 441b. Because the basis for the recommendation was set forth in the First GCR, and in order to consolidate the RTB Notification with those recommended in that Report, this Office requests that the Commission vote on this additional recommendation on a 24 Hour tally vote.
