During our recent telephone conversation, you asked a few follow-up questions about my recent submissions to the Commission. I write in response to those questions.

Gary Glenewinkel did not reimburse any Centex Rooney employee for federal campaign contributions other than D.J. McGlothern. Mr. McGlothern's campaign contributions were made on his own behalf and were not disguised contributions on behalf of Mr. Glenewinkel. Further, none of my clients pressured Mr. McGlothern into making any campaign contributions. Indeed, I have never heard that anyone else pressured, or attempted to pressure, Mr. McGlothern. Mr. Glenewinkel received copies of Mr. McGlothern's checks directly from Mr. McGlothern, and not from anyone else at Centex Rooney. Mr. Glenewinkel did not inferra anyone at Center Rooney that the contributions Mr. McGlothern made were actually Mr. Glenewinkel's contributions. Finally, Ted Adams has no recollection of any involvement with Mr. McGlothern's contributions, contribution checks or reimbursements.
