On February 16, 2005, the Federal Election Commission accepted the signed conciliation agreement and the civil penalty you submitted on behalf of the Paul Williams Campaign and yourself, in your official capacity as treasurer, in settlement of a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 432(h)(2), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, the file has been closed in this matter.
