



CONSENT TO EXTEND THE TIME TO INSTITUTE A CIVIL
LAW ENFORCEMENT ACTION

As consideration for the Federal Election Commission's ("Commission's") agreement to conduct settlement negotiations and to extend the period for responding to the General Counsel's Brief dated May 4, 2004 to June 22, 2004, Respondent Paul A. Matteucci hereby consents to toll the statute of limitations of any civil enforcement action that the Commission might institute in connection with MUR 5383 pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(6) for an additional period of seven (7) calendar days. This agreement, together with Respondent's prior statute of limitations tolling agreements dated February 23, 2004 and June 3, 2004, will extend the expiration date of the five-year statute of limitations found at 28 U.S.C. § 2462, or any other statute of limitations or repose that may be applicable in this matter, for a total period of seventy-seven (77) calendar days. There shall be no additional consent to extend the time to institute a civil law enforcement action without the written consent of the Respondent or his representative.
