This is in reference to the matter involving Jose Casal, which your office referred to the Federal Election Commission.


On October 1, 2003, the Commission found that there was reason to believe Jose Casal violated 2 U.S.C. § 441e(a), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and has now entered into a conciliation agreement in the matter.
