On September 30, 2004, your clients, the Republican National Committee and Bob Kjellander, in his official capacity as treasurer (collectively "RNC"), were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that the RNC violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b and initiated an investigation in the matter. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on April 17, 2006, to take no further action against the RNC and closed the file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
