Dear Mr. Bauer:

On September 14, 2004, the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that your client, SER Corp. d/b/a Galileo Restaurant ("Galileo") violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b and initiated an investigation in the matter. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on April 17, 2006, to take no further action as to Galileo, and closed the file in this matter.

As you were previously notified, the basis of the Commission's reason to believe finding was information suggesting that Galileo provided food and beverages for use in a candidate's campaign at a discount greater than \$1,000 in an election. The Commission reminds Galileo that doing so would violate 11 C.F.R. § 114.1(a)(2)(v).

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003).
