
Dear Mr. Reiff:

On April 1, 2004, the Federal Election Commission accepted the signed conciliation agreement submitted on behalf of your clients, the Democratic Party of Virginia—Federal Campaign Committee and Abbi G. Easter, as treasurer ("Respondents"), in settlement of Respondents' violations of 2 U.S.C. § 434(b), a provision of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, the file has been closed in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). Information derived in connection with any conciliation attempt will not become public without the written consent of the Respondents and the Commission. *See* 2 U.S.C. § 437g(a)(4)(B).
