
In a letter dated October 30, 2003, the Federal Election Commission notified the Richard C. Levitt Family Lecture Endowment Fund, the University of Iowa, and the University of Iowa College of Law of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On May 6, 2004, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint and information provided by you and other respondents, that there is no reason to believe the Richard C. Levitt Family Lecture Endowment Fund, the University of Iowa, or the University of Iowa College of Law violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(a)(1)(A). Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). A copy of the General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.
