
Dear Mr. Capece:

On November 5, 2003, the Federal Election Commission notified your clients of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended ("the Act"). On January 7, 2005, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, evidence presented in the responses, and information available to the public, that there is no reason to believe that the Union County Democratic Committee and Joseph Bodek, as treasurer, violated the Act. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. *See* Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed.
