DECLARATION


1. This Declaration is voluntarily made and sworn to by me the undersigned, Colin Strother. I am currently Chief of Staff for Congressman Henry Cuellar. During the period from approximately November 1, 2003, through December 31, 2004, I was an agent and official of the Texans for Henry Cuellar Congressional Committee. In that capacity I acquired knowledge of the automated, in-house auto-dialer telephone system used by the Committee for certain campaign communications, including those that are alleged to have been made in connection with this pending matter. Furthermore, in preparing to make this sworn declaration I reviewed Committee records and other information pertaining to the Committee's use of the described automated telephone system.

2. Based upon that review and to the best of my knowledge, information and belief, the Committee's auto-dialer telephone system was not used, during the period cited above, to make more than 500 scripted telephone calls (that is, calls with identical or substantially similar message content), within any period of 30 consecutive days.
