DECLARATION


1. This Declaration is voluntarily made by me the undersigned, Colin Strother. I am currently Chief of Staff for Congressman Henry Cueller. During the period beginning approximately November 1, 2003, and continuing to December 31, 2004, I was an agent and official of the Texans for Henry Cuellar Congressional Committee. In that capacity I acquired knowledge of the bank loan transactions entered into by the Committee and Mr. Henry Cueller, who had authorized the Committee as his principal campaign committee under the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended.

2. To the best of my knowledge, information and belief, during the period cited above and continuing to the date of this Declaration, the Committee and Mr. Cueller have not obtained any bank loans for campaign purposes, other than the \$200,000 loan from the International Bank of Commerce of Laredo, Texas, on February 3, 2004, which is the subject loan of this MUR.

In addition, if such new loans are obtained and thereafter restructured, the required information for the restructured loan will be reported in a timely manner to the FEC on Schedule C-1.
