Dear Mr. Oldaker and Mr. Litchfield:

This is in response to your February 2 letter, which we received on February 7, 2006, requesting an extension of 20 days to respond to the General Counsel's Brief in the above-referenced matters. As basis for this request, you state that additional time is required in order to respond to "questions" posed in our January 30, 2006 letter, to contact certain witnesses, and to locate documents in Texas. You also cite Mr. Litchfield's recent travel schedule.

Although this Office routinely grants extension for good cause, and Mr. Litchfield's travel schedule constitutes good cause for a short extension, certain aspects of your letter do not accurately reflect the circumstances of this matter. First, there are no new questions posed in our letter for you to answer.
