After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on April 24, 2007, to take no further action as to SEIU United Healthcare Workers West f/k/a SEIU Local 250; Sal Rosselli, President; and John Borsos, Administrative Vice President, and closed the file in this matter.
