On September 23, 2004, October 25, 2004, and June 17, 2005, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint against Jack Frost and Friends alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On April 4, 2006, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by you on behalf of Jack Frost and Friends, that there is no reason to believe Jack Frost and Friends violated the Act. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter as it pertains to Jack Frost and Friends.

The Commission reminds you that the confidentiality provisions of 2 U S C § 437g(a)(12)(A) remain in effect, and that this matter is still open with respect to other respondents. The Commission will notify you when the entire file has been closed, at which time you will be sent a copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report.
