On February 8, 2006, the Federal Election Commission reviewed the allegations in your complaint dated October 22, 2004 and found that on the basis of the information provided in your complaint, and information provided by the respondents, there is no reason to believe Representative Neil Abercrombie, Abercrombie for Congress and Jack Y. Endo, in his official capacity as treasurer, accepted contributions in violation of the Act or the Commission's regulations, as alleged in this matter. Accordingly, on February 8, 2006, the Commission closed the file in this matter.


