This is in response to your letter dated July 7, 2006, which we received on that date, requesting an extension of at least 20 days to respond to the Commission's reason to believe findings in the above-referenced MUR.

Considering the Federal Election Commission's responsibilities to act expeditiously in the conduct of investigations, the Office of the General Counsel cannot grant your full request, but can only agree to a 10-day extension for Ms. Cain and a 20-day extension for Mr. Swinford.
