On June 19, 2006, you were notified that the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that you violated 2 U.S.C. § 441f. On July 26, 2006, you submitted a response to the Commission's reason to believe findings. After considering the circumstances of the matter, the Commission determined on October 23, 2007 to take no further action as to Joseph R. James, Jr. and May I. James, and closed the file in this matter.

The Commission reminds you that allowing your names to be used to make contributions for which you are reimbursed is a violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441f. You should take steps to ensure that this activity does not occur in the future.
