On June 20, 2006, the Federal Election Commission found reason to believe that Crop Production Services, Inc. ("CPS") and Thomas Warner each violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441b(a) and 441f, and found reason to believe that Alan Steele, Denny Horstman, Duane Mol, Debra Warner and Nancy Steele each violated 2 U.S.C. § 441f.

Also on January 9, 2007, the Commission determined to take no further action regarding Debra Warner and Nancy Steele and closed the file as to them.
