Dear Mr. Dezsi:

On August 25, 2009, the Federal Election Commission found that there is probable cause to believe that your clients, Fieger, Fieger, Kenney, Johnson and Giroux, P.C., Geoffrey Nels Fieger, and Vernon R. Johnson, violated 2 U.S.C. §§ 441b and 441f, provisions of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, Chapters 95 and 96 of Title 26, U.S. Code, by using and consenting to the use of corporate funds to make \$113,000 of contributions in the name of another to the Edwards Committee. The Commission also found that there is probable cause to believe that Geoffrey Nels Fieger violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a by using personal funds to make \$18,000 in additional excessive contributions and contributions in the name of another to the Edwards Committee.
