Dear Mr. Jordan,

This is a response to your correspondence of 10/17/2006 received on 10/20/2006 regarding matter (~~MUR 5839~~), a complaint against Blessinger For Congress (#C00426106) and its treasurer George Sambus. The complaint stated that the campaign failed to properly report known campaign expenses and in-kind contributions with the FEC as of 8/31/2006.


Martin W. Blessinger applied for federal candidacy on 7/3/2006 and Blessinger For Congress applied for organization and named a treasurer and assistant treasurer on 7/3/2006. (Please see attached FEC form 1 and 2) Mr. Blessinger officially became a candidate on 7/17/2006 when his contributions exceeded \$5000. (Please see attached Chase bank statement) Expenditures for the period 7/3/2006 to 7/31/2006 were \$1480.16 and did not exceed \$5000 in that period. Taking these facts into account, **Martin W. Blessinger became a candidate on 7/17/2006** when campaign contributions exceeded \$5000. (Please see attached Chase bank statement)

Referring to page #61 of the Campaign Guide For Congressional Candidates and Committees, "Once an individual has become a candidate, his or her principal campaign committee ... must file quarterly reports. Quarterly reports cover activity through the end of the calendar quarter and are due on April 15, July 15, and October 15." (See attached copy of page 62 of the Campaign Guide) The Blessinger Campaign reported activity covering 7/1/2006 to 9/30/2006 on the 10/15/2006 due date, and activity covering 10/1/2006 through 10/18/2006 on the 10/26/2006 due date as required.


The Blessinger For Congress campaign has meticulously followed all FEC rules and is therefore not in any violation.

A similar safe harbor exists for reports delivered to an overnight mail service on or before the 15th day before the election. Otherwise pre-election reports must arrive at the appropriate filing office by the 12th day before the election

Authorized committees must file appropriate pre- and post-election reports even if the candidate is unopposed or if the election is not held. Advisory Opinion 1986-21

Post-General Election Reports

There is no requirement for post-primary reports, but a committee must file a post-general election report if the candidate runs in the general election. A post-general election report covers activity through the 20th day after the election and is due 30 days after the election 104.5(a)(1)(ii).

Last-Minute Contributions (48-Hour Notice)

Campaign committees must file special notices regarding contributions of \$1,000 or more received less than 20 days but more than 48 hours before 12:01 a.m. of the day of any election in which the candidate is running. (These are often called "48-Hour Notices.") This rule applies to all types of contributions to any authorized committee of the candidate including

- Contributions from the candidate,
- Loans from the candidate and other non-bank sources, and
- Endorsements or guarantees of loans from banks. (See page 13.)

Committees may file their 48-hour notices using FEC Form 6. Alternatively a paper-filing committee may file online using the FEC's web site or may use its own paper or stationery for the notice provided that it contains the following information:
