I attach appearances to represent New Trier Democratic Organization-Fed, and its treasurer, Marvin Miller in the above matter.

The respondents received this notice on Monday, November 6, 2006, and a response is due within 15 days. The conduct complained of relates to the November 7, 2006 election, now past. Immediately after the election, I had responsibilities to other, especially urgent election-related matters on behalf of the local election authority (Cook County, Illinois), and in the week of November 13, 2006, was in Springfield, Illinois, representing clients before the state legislature. Because I was out of town, I first was able to see a copy of the complaint on Friday, November 17, 2006, and agreed to represent the parties that day. I will need a reasonable amount of time to prepare an appropriate response to your inquiry. It is my intention and belief that an appropriate response to you can be submitted in 14 days, by December 5, 2006.
