SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

Candidate Nate Holden is presently running in a primary election for the House of Representatives in the 28th Congressional District of California. He is also a state senator. The complainant alleges that Holden's Congressional campaign committee has failed to disclose the original sources of a \$9000 contribution which it received from his state campaign committee. Consequently the Congressional committee is allegedly in violation of section 434(b)(2) of the Act. The complainant also notes that the sources of this contribution may have been corporations or labor unions. Such contributions would be in violation of section 441b of the Act.

In addition, the complaint alleges that the Congressional committee must consolidate and report all contribution information of the state committee pursuant to section 432(e)(2) of the Act. The complainant also alleges that the state committee must file quarterly reports with the Clerk of the House as required by section 434 of the Act.

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

On April 28, 1978, prior to the receipt of this complaint, the Reports Analysis Division mailed a request for additional information to the candidate's Congressional committee. Included was a statement (Attachment I) requesting clarification of the \$9000 contribution which appeared on the committee's April 10, 1978 quarterly report. The letter from Reports Analysis cited section 104.2(b)(2) of the Regulations, which requires that such reports must disclose the identification, occupation, and principal place of business of persons who have made contributions

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in excess of \$100 during the reporting period.

After telephone conversations between the Congressional committee's treasurer and the Reports Analysis Division, the requested information was received at the Commission on May 15, 1978. This mailing represents an amendment to the April 10 quarterly report. The amended report discloses that \$6500 of the \$9000 in question was contributed by individuals in amounts of \$1000 or less. The reporting of the individual contributors' names, addresses, and occupations satisfies the requirements of section 104.2(b)(2) of the Regulations and section 434(b)(2) of the Act.

There were also however, three contributions of \$1000, \$1000, and \$500 which could have been from labor unions, political action committees, or corporations. On May 23, 1978, the Commission received a letter from the Holden Congressional committee stating that it had voluntarily returned two of the three questionable contributions amounting to \$2000 to the Holden state committee. A copy of a \$2000 check from the Congressional committee to the state committee was included.

The Holden Congressional committee therefore, had use of the \$2000 from the reported date of the contribution until the date of repayment. The April 10 quarterly report reveals that the contribution was received by the Congressional committee on February 17, 1978. The Congressional committee returned the contribution on or about May 12, 1978, the date which appeared on the xeroxed check from the Congressional committee to the state committee.

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While the Office of General Counsel realizes that repayment of a corporate campaign contribution does not necessarily vitiate a violation of section 441b of the Act, the funds in this instance were only in the committee's control for approximately three months. In light of this fact and in light of the fact that the contribution was voluntarily returned prior to the June 6th primary election, we would recommend that no action be taken on this issue.

No explanation has been received for a \$500 contribution from the "Tucker Land Company" whose address is given as 10100 Santa Monica Boulevard, Los Angeles, California. Telephone conversations with the California Secretary of State's office on May 30, 1978 reveal that there is no "Tucker Land Company/ Corporation" on either their active or inactive list of corporations. Considering the apparent non-corporate status of the contributor, it appears that the committee is not in violation of section 441b of the Act with respect to the \$500 contribution.

Another issue raised in the complaint is whether the candidate's state committee has satisfied the reporting requirements under the Act. It appears that the necessary reporting requirements were satisfied by the previously mentioned amendment to the April 10 quarterly report submitted to the Commission by Holden's Congressional committee.

The applicable section of the Regulations to the present situation is 104.10. It states that political committees having "cash on hand" at the time of registration must disclose in their

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report the sources of these funds, including information required under section 104.2 of the Regulations.

Holden's Congressional committee registered by submitting its statement of organization to the Commission on February 27, 1978. The contributions listed on the amendment to its April 10 report were all made prior to this date. Such funds could therefore, be considered "cash on hand" at the time Holden's Congressional committee filed its statement of organization within the meaning of section 104.10. Information required under section 104.2 concerning the sources of these funds has been disclosed by Holden's Congressional committee. It appears therefore, that the Congressional committee has complied with section 104.10 of the Regulations.

CONCLUSION

On the question of whether the \$2000 corporate contribution should be considered a violation of section 441b of the Act, in light of the fact that the funds were held by the committee for only three months and were returned voluntarily prior to the primary election, no action should be taken.

Concerning the \$500 contribution from the "Tucker Land Company", it is apparently not a corporate contribution and therefore not in violation of section 441b of the Act.

As to the reporting requirements of the committees, Holden's Congressional committee has complied with all the necessary re-

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quirements of section 104.10, the applicable section of the Regulations to the present situation.

Pursuant to Section 111.2 of Title 11 of the Code of Federal Regulations, I hereby file a Complaint with the Federal Election Commission and set forth my grounds for believing that Nate Holden, Nate Holden Campaign Committee (Federal) and Nate Holden Campaign Committee (State) have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 as amended, 2 U.S.C. §431 et seq. ("FECA") in the particulars described below. Nate Holden ("Holden") is a current candidate for the Democratic nomination for Member of the United States House of Representatives for the 28th District of California in a primary election to be held in June 1978. Nate Holden Campaign Committee-Federal ("Holden Congress Committee") is the "principal campaign committee", as defined in 11 C.F.R. §100.14(1), used by Holden in his campaign for the Democratic nomination. Holden is currently a State Senator for the 30th State Senatorial District in California.

The facts upon which this Complaint are as follows. Attached as Exhibit "A" hereto is the quarterly report of contributions and expenditures filed by the Holden Congress Committee with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or about April 10, 1978 ("the April Quarterly Report"). The April Quarterly Report discloses, on page 1 of Schedule A, that the Holden Congress Committee received a \$9,000 contribution (the "Contribution") from the Nate Holden Campaign

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Committee (State). This Committee operated Holden's past campaign for California State Senator and is herein referred to as the "Holden State Senate Committee". The April Quarterly Report does not itemize or disclose the persons, firms, committees or corporations who originally contributed sums to the Holden State Senate Committee, which sums were used to make the Contribution.

The failure of the April Quarterly Report to disclose or itemize the source(s) of the Contribution presents reasonable cause to believe that the Holden Congress Committee, the Holden State Senate Committee and Holden have violated FECA in the following respects, among others:

1. (a) 11 C.F.R. §104.2(b)(2) requires a principal campaign committee to disclose "the identification, occupation and principal place of business of each person who has made a contribution to or for" the committee or candidate, in excess of \$100, as well as the amount of the contribution. The original source(s) of the Contribution not the affiliated Holden State Senate Committee, are under FECA the "person(s) who [have] made a contribution to or for" Holden and Holden Congress Committee. The appropriate information concerning such original source(s) is not disclosed on the April Quarterly Report.

(b) The Campaign Guide for Congressional Candidates and Their Committees, published by the Federal Election Commission, states on page 4:

"Transfers between a candidate's previous campaign committee and his/her currently registered campaign committee [do not count as contributions], as long as none of the transferred funds contain contributions which would be illegal under the Act. . . . If the previous campaign was for a State office, the original donors of contributions exceeding \$100 must be fully itemized. It is assumed that the last contributions received by the State campaign committee are those transferred to the current Federal campaign committee. The Federal campaign committee may not . . . accept any such funds which would be illegal under the Act. [11 C.F.R.] §104.10." (emphasis added)

Attached as Exhibit "B" hereto is the report filed by the Holden State Senate Committee with the State of California for the last six months of 1977. This report discloses substantial contributions from corporations and labor

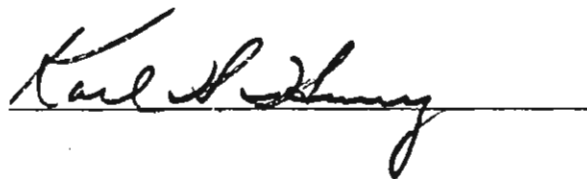
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organizations, which would not be permissible under Federal law. Unless the Holden State Senate Committee can establish that it received \$9,000 in contributions in 1978 prior to the transfer of the Contribution, operation of the rule of 11 C.F.R. §104.10 previously cited would establish that the source of the Contribution was illegal contributions by corporations or labor organizations.

3. The transfer of the Contribution and the use of the Holden State Senate Committee to receive funds for the Holden Congress Committee, among other facts, establishes that the Holden State Senate Committee is an "authorized committee" or "affiliated committee" pursuant to 11 C.F.R. §100.14(b)(1), (c)(1), (2)(i)(E), and (2)(ii)(E). As such, the Holden Congress Committee is obligated under 11 C.F.R. §104.2(c) to consolidate, in its April Quarterly Report, contribution information of the Holden State Senate Committee. The Holden State Senate Committee is obligated to register or make filings as a "political committee" under 11 C.F.R. §102.1 and to file quarterly reports under 11 C.F.R. §104.1(a). Neither of the Holden Congress Committee nor the Holden State Senate Committee have complied with the foregoing requirements. These requirements mandate disclosure and itemization of the appropriate information of the original source(s) of the Contribution on the April Quarterly Report.

I hereby request that the Federal Election Commission determine that it has "reason to believe" that Holden, Holden Congress Committee and Holden State Senate Committee are in violation of FECA. I am filing this Complaint on behalf of Julian Dixon who is a candidate for the Democratic nomination for Member of the House of Representatives for the 28th District of California.

Pursuant to Section 111.2 of Title 11 of the Code of Federal Regulations, I hereby file a Complaint with the Federal Election Commission and set forth my grounds for believing that Nate Holden, Nate Holden Campaign Committee (Federal) and Nate Holden Campaign Committee (State) have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 as amended, 2 U.S.C. §431 et seq. ("FECA") in the particulars described below. Nate Holden ("Holden") is a current candidate for the Democratic nomination for Member of the United States House of Representatives for the 28th District of California in a primary election to be held in June 1978. Nate Holden Campaign Committee-Federal ("Holden Congress Committee") is the "principal campaign committee", as defined in 11 C.F.R. §100.14(1), used by Holden in his campaign for the Democratic nomination. Holden is currently a State Senator for the 30th State Senatorial District in California.

The facts upon which this Complaint are as follows. Attached as Exhibit "A" hereto is the quarterly report of contributions and expenditures filed by the Holden Congress Committee with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or about April 10, 1978 ("the April Quarterly Report"). The April Quarterly Report discloses, on page 1 of Schedule A, that the Holden Congress Committee received a \$9,000 contribution (the "Contribution") from the Nate Holden Campaign

Committee (State). This Committee operated Holden's past campaign for California State Senator and is herein referred to as the "Holden State Senate Committee". The April Quarterly Report does not itemize or disclose the persons, firms, committees or corporations who originally contributed sums to the Holden State Senate Committee, which sums were used to make the Contribution.

The failure of the April Quarterly Report to disclose or itemize the source(s) of the Contribution presents reasonable cause to believe that the Holden Congress Committee, the Holden State Senate Committee and Holden have violated FECA in the following respects, among others:

1. (a) 11 C.F.R. §104.2(b)(2) requires a principal campaign committee to disclose "the identification, occupation and principal place of business of each person who has made a contribution to or for" the committee or candidate, in excess of \$100, as well as the amount of the contribution. The original source(s) of the Contribution not the affiliated Holden State Senate Committee, are under FECA the "person(s) who [have] made a contribution to or for" Holden and Holden Congress Committee. The appropriate information concerning such original source(s) is not disclosed on the April Quarterly Report.

(b) The Campaign Guide for Congressional Candidates and Their Committees, published by the Federal Election Commission, states on page 4:

"Transfers between a candidate's previous campaign committee and his/her currently registered campaign committee [do not count as contributions], as long as none of the transferred funds contain contributions which would be illegal under the Act. . . . If the previous campaign was for a State office, the original donors of contributions exceeding \$100 must be fully itemized. It is assumed that the last contributions received by the State campaign committee are those transferred to the current Federal campaign committee. The Federal campaign committee may not . . . accept any such funds which would be illegal under the Act. [11 C.F.R.] §104.10." (emphasis added)

Attached as Exhibit "B" hereto is the report filed by the Holden State Senate Committee with the State of California for the last six months of 1977. This report discloses substantial contributions from corporations and labor

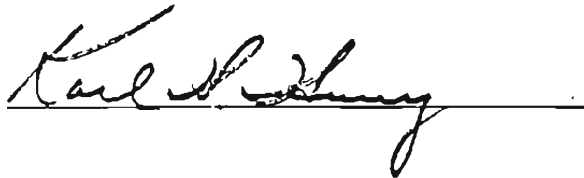

organizations, which would not be permissible under Federal law. Unless the Holden State Senate Committee can establish that it received \$9,000 in contributions in 1978 prior to the transfer of the Contribution, operation of the rule of 11 C.F.R. §104.10 previously cited would establish that the source of the Contribution was illegal contributions by corporations or labor organizations.

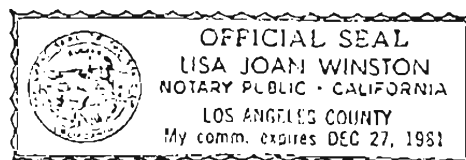
3. The transfer of the Contribution and the use of the Holden State Senate Committee to receive funds for the Holden Congress Committee, among other facts, establishes that the Holden State Senate Committee is an "authorized committee" or "affiliated committee" pursuant to 11 C.F.R. §100.14(b)(1), (c)(1), (2)(i)(E), and (2)(ii)(E). As such, the Holden Congress Committee is obligated under 11 C.F.R. §104.2(c) to consolidate, in its April Quarterly Report, contribution information of the Holden State Senate Committee. The Holden State Senate Committee is obligated to register or make filings as a "political committee" under 11 C.F.R. §102.1 and to file quarterly reports under 11 C.F.R. §104.1(a). Neither of the Holden Congress Committee nor the Holden State Senate Committee have complied with the foregoing requirements. These requirements mandate disclosure and itemization of the appropriate information of the original source(s) of the Contribution on the April Quarterly Report.

I hereby request that the Federal Election Commission determine that it has "reason to believe" that Holden, Holden Congress Committee and Holden State Senate Committee are in violation of FECA. I am filing this Complaint on behalf of Julian Dixon who is a candidate for the Democratic nomination for Member of the House of Representatives for the 28th District of California.

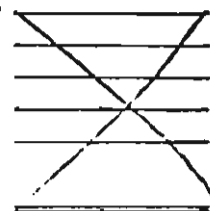

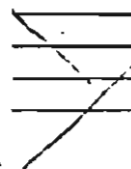

Pursuant to Section 111.2 of Title 11 of the Code of Federal Regulations, I hereby file a Complaint with the Federal Election Commission and set forth my grounds for believing that Nate Holden, Nate Holden Campaign Committee (Federal) and Nate Holden Campaign Committee (State) have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971 as amended, 2 U.S.C. §431 et seq. ("FECA") in the particulars described below. Nate Holden ("Holden") is a current candidate for the Democratic nomination for Member of the United States House of Representatives for the 28th District of California in a primary election to be held in June 1978. Nate Holden Campaign Committee-Federal ("Holden Congress Committee") is the "principal campaign committee", as defined in 11 C.F.R. §100.14(1), used by Holden in his campaign for the Democratic nomination. Holden is currently a State Senator for the 30th State Senatorial District in California.

The facts upon which this Complaint are as follows. Attached as Exhibit "A" hereto is the quarterly report of contributions and expenditures filed by the Holden Congress Committee with the Clerk of the House of Representatives on or about April 10, 1978 ("the April Quarterly Report"). The April Quarterly Report discloses, on page 1 of Schedule A, that the Holden Congress Committee received a \$9,000 contribution (the "Contribution") from the Nate Holden Campaign

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Committee (State). This Committee operated Holden's past campaign for California State Senator and is herein referred to as the "Holden State Senate Committee". The April Quarterly Report does not itemize or disclose the persons, firms, committees or corporations who originally contributed sums to the Holden State Senate Committee, which sums were used to make the Contribution.

The failure of the April Quarterly Report to disclose or itemize the source(s) of the Contribution presents reasonable cause to believe that the Holden Congress Committee, the Holden State Senate Committee and Holden have violated FECA in the following respects, among others:

1. (a) 11 C.F.R. §104.2(b)(2) requires a principal campaign committee to disclose "the identification, occupation and principal place of business of each person who has made a contribution to or for" the committee or candidate, in excess of \$100, as well as the amount of the contribution. The original source(s) of the Contribution not the affiliated Holden State Senate Committee, are under FECA the "person(s) who [have] made a contribution to or for" Holden and Holden Congress Committee. The appropriate information concerning such original source(s) is not disclosed on the April Quarterly Report.

(b) The Campaign Guide for Congressional Candidates and Their Committees, published by the Federal Election Commission, states on page 4:

"Transfers between a candidate's previous campaign committee and his/her currently registered campaign committee [do not count as contributions], as long as none of the transferred funds contain contributions which would be illegal under the Act. . . . If the previous campaign was for a State office, the original donors of contributions exceeding \$100 must be fully itemized. It is assumed that the last contributions received by the State campaign committee are those transferred to the current Federal campaign committee. The Federal campaign committee may not . . . accept any such funds which would be illegal under the Act. [11 C.F.R.] §104.10." (emphasis added)

Attached as Exhibit "B" hereto is the report filed by the Holden State Senate Committee with the State of California for the last six months of 1977. This report discloses substantial contributions from corporations and labor

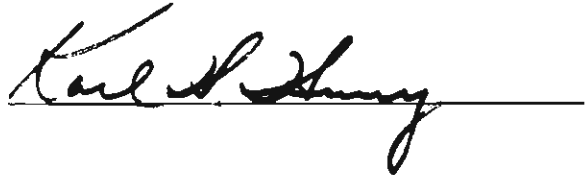

organizations, which would not be permissible under Federal law. Unless the Holden State Senate Committee can establish that it received \$9,000 in contributions in 1978 prior to the transfer of the Contribution, operation of the rule of 11 C.F.R. §104.10 previously cited would establish that the source of the Contribution was illegal contributions by corporations or labor organizations.

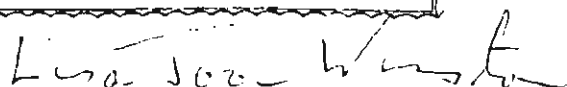
3. The transfer of the Contribution and the use of the Holden State Senate Committee to receive funds for the Holden Congress Committee, among other facts, establishes that the Holden State Senate Committee is an "authorized committee" or "affiliated committee" pursuant to 11 C.F.R. §100.14(b)(1), (c)(1), (2)(i)(E), and (2)(ii)(E). The Holden State Senate Committee is obligated to register or make filings as a "political committee" under 11 C.F.R. §102.1 and to file quarterly reports under 11 C.F.R. §104.1(a). Neither of the Holden Congress Committee nor the Holden State Senate Committee have complied with the foregoing requirements. These requirements mandate disclosure and itemization of the appropriate information of the original source(s) of the Contribution on the April Quarterly Report.

I hereby request that the Federal Election Commission determine that it has "reason to believe" that Holden, Holden Congress Committee and Holden State Senate Committee are in violation of FECA. I am filing this Complaint on behalf of Julian Dixon who is a candidate for the Democratic nomination for Member of the House of Representatives for the 28th District of California.
