As a candidate for Congress in New Hampshire's Second Congressional District, I have worked hard to comply with the Federal Election Commission's rules and reporting guidelines. It is therefore quite disturbing to learn that one of my opponents has been failing to follow these rules almost from the beginning of her campaign. Jennifer Horn for Congress, C00446914, has habitually used general election funds to pay for campaign expenditures during the primary. Such use is clearly prohibited, and I would ask the FEC to impose appropriate penalties on the campaign and the candidate.

By examining both the First Quarter (FEC-333571) and Second Quarter (FEC-351517) filings, a clear pattern emerges. Horn received several early "Max Out" contributions in excess of \$2300, which are not available to the campaign until September 10, 2008. However, the campaign's expenditures regularly exceeded the amount of cash on hand available to it during the primary. After days or weeks of using General Election funds, Horn would make a substantial personal loan to her own campaign to bring her cash on hand back above zero.

Since unitemized receipts and expenditures are not listed by date in the FEC reports, it is impossible to tell when this money was available to the campaign. But even under the most generous interpretation, that every dollar came in on the first day of the quarter, the Horn campaign still far exceeded the primary funds available to it. More realistically, these small dollar contributions trickle in throughout the quarter.

The attached summaries of Jennifer Horn for Congress's own reports show the campaign with a negative primary balance from March 18 to March 31, on May 5, and from May 20 to May 22. Again, this assumes that every dollar in unitemized receipts was available on the first day of the filing period. Realistically, the campaign funded its operating deficit with General Election money for weeks at a time.

I would ask that the Commission determine exactly how much money was in the Horn campaign primary election account throughout the past six months in order to determine how much in General Election funds were used to pay for the primary campaign. Blatantly cooking the books should not go unpunished.

Thank you for your prompt attention to this serious matter.

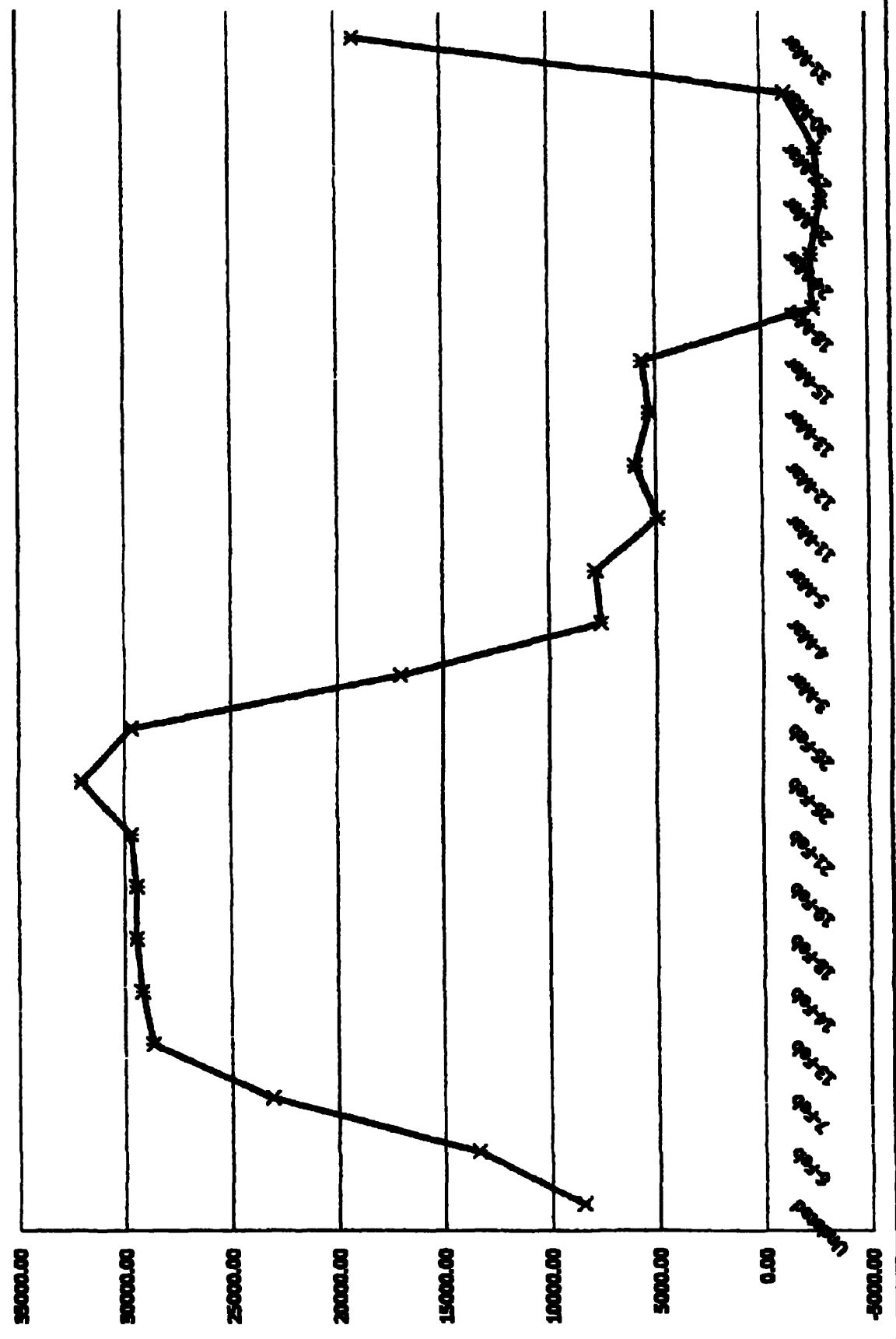

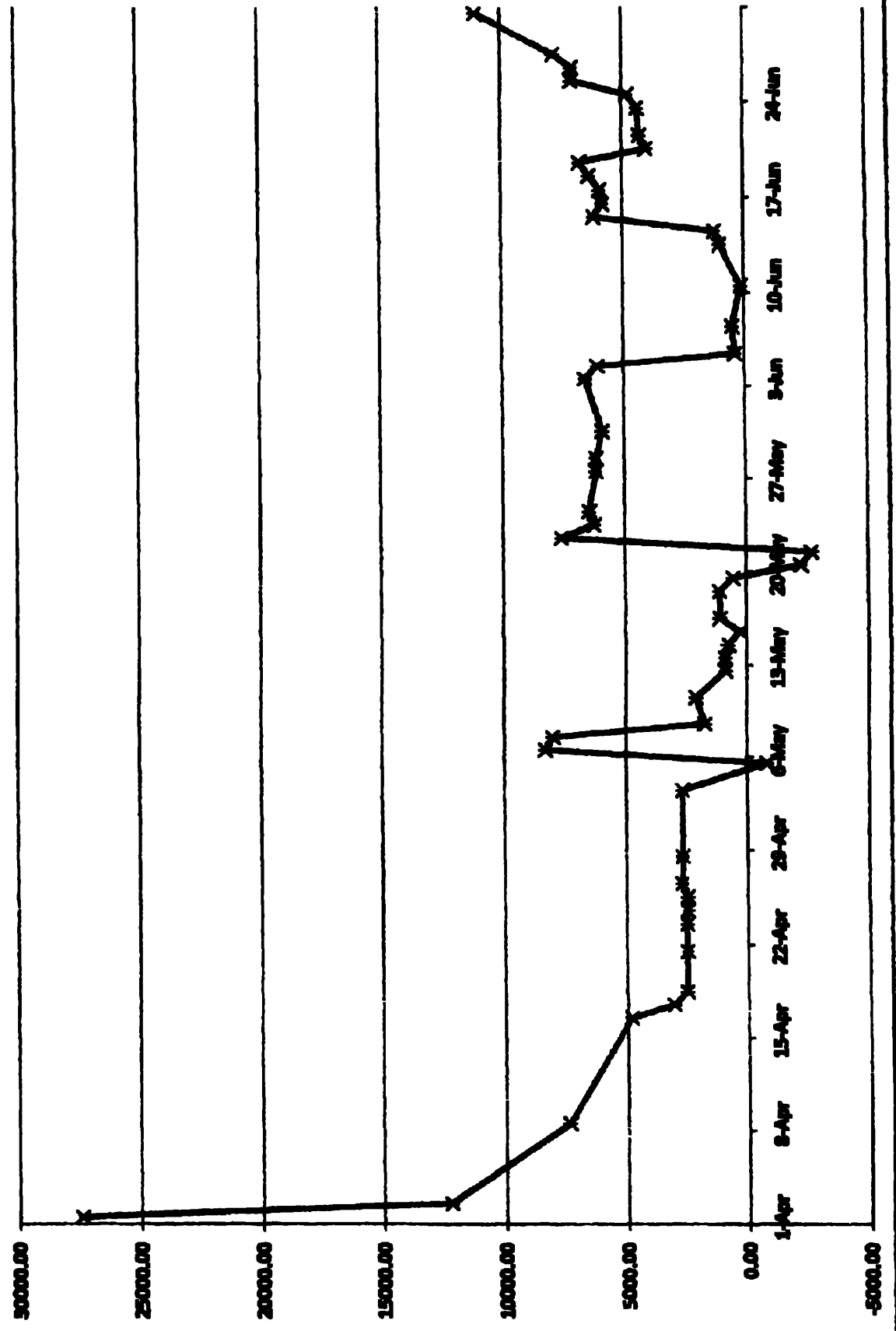
