On November 3, 2008 the Federal Election Commission notified Jacob Turk for Congress ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On May 15, 2009, the Commission found, on the basis of the information in the complaint, and information provided by the Committee that there is no reason to believe Jacob Turk for Congress and you, as treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 434(b), and 2 U.S.C. § 441b. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). A copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.
