On May 19, 2009, the Commission found reason to believe that Craig for U.S. Senate ("Committee") and former Senator Larry E. Craig ("Craig") violated 2 U.S.C. § 439a(b) and, after an investigation, on July 27, 2010, authorized OGC to engage in pre-probable cause conciliation with the Respondents. The Commission approved an opening settlement offer

This Memorandum is to inform the Commission that conciliation negotiations with Respondents have terminated.
