Complaint of Over Limit Contributions and Request for Audit - Obama for America (C00431445) and Obama Victory Fund (C00451393)

Dear Sir or Madam:

This is a complaint pertaining to the Presidential Campaign Funds of Barack Obama. There are a lot of questions about his funding sources and just cursory examination of his donations for the States of Idaho, Montana, Nebraska, Nevada, and Indiana show numerous contributions exceeding campaign contribution limits:

Due to the sheer volume of transactions, it is not practical for an individual to review all of the donations for discrepancies however, problems are apparent just looking at filtered segments of the donations in these all of states. In examining 7785 records, I found 13 donors (listing(s) attached) who contributed \$200.00 to \$5,100.00 to the Obama for America fund. In these 6 states, the amount in excess of \$4,600 per donor came to \$20,299.84. This total represents an average of \$1561.52 per donor in excess of the \$4,600.00 maximum allowed.

The American People need an audit of the Obama for America (C00431445) and Obama Victory Fund (C00451393). The sheer volume of transactions prohibits transparency. We are depending on the FEC to assure compliance with fair practices. Please audit the Obama Presidential Campaign Funds. Thank you for your time and consideration.

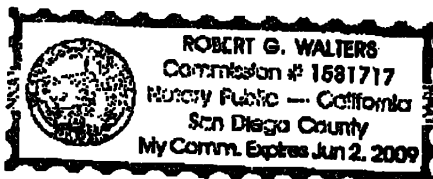
