On March 30, 2009, the Federal Election Commission notified the 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District Democratic Party of Wisconsin of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On September 23, 2009, based upon the information contained in the complaint, and information provided by the 1<sup>st</sup> Congressional District Democratic Party of Wisconsin, the Commission decided to dismiss the complaint and closed its file in this matter. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on September 23, 2009.
