On June 15, 2009, the Federal Election Commission notified Schmidt for Congress Committee ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On August 20, 2009, based upon the information contained in the complaint, and information provided by the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission decided to dismiss the complaint and closed its file in this matter. Accordingly, the Commission closed its file in this matter on August 20, 2009.
