Dear General Counsel:

I have personal knowledge and a good faith belief that David H. Krikorian (FEC ID# H8OH02090) and the Krikorian for Congress Committee (FEC ID# C00449330) have violated the prohibition of receiving corporate contributions as set forth by the Federal Election Commission. The law as I understand it prohibits corporations from making contributions or expenditures from their general treasury funds in connection with any election of any candidate for federal office.

On or about June 22, 2009 the Armenian National Committee of America (a corporation) sent a national email fundraising appeal (see exhibit 1) to an unknown list of supporters. On or about June 24, 2009 the Armenian Weekly (a corporation) a national news organization published that fundraising appeal (see exhibit 2) in its entirety making a direct appeal to its readers to contribute to the campaign of Mr. Krikorian. Neither fundraising appeal contained any of the necessary and legally required disclosures regarding who paid for the appeal, who may give to the candidate or what the tax ramifications may be.

Further it appears by the finance disclosure filed by the Krikorian campaign that as much as \$45,000 may have been raised in this illegal manner.

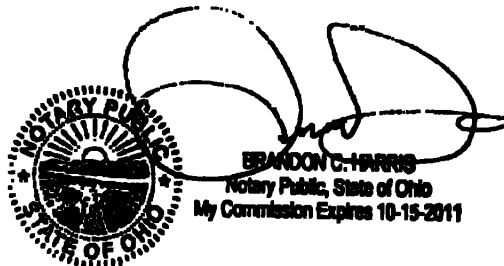
It is apparent that both the Armenian National Committee of America and the Armenian Weekly newspaper have used corporate resources to the significant benefit of Mr. Krikorian's campaign for the United States House of Representatives.

I hereby request that your office further investigate this matter and issue proper penalties to David Krikorian, the Krikorian for Congress Committee and the corporations involved for violations of the FECA. This complaint is submitted for your consideration, I hereby swear to my good faith basis to the facts submitted in this complaint as shown by my notarized signature.
