Morrison, Jr., that the Federal Election Commission ("Commission") had ascertained information in the normal course of carrying out its supervisory responsibilities indicating that Mr. Morrison may have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, in connection with a contribution made to David Vitter for U.S. Senate.

After considering the circumstances in this matter, the Commission decided to close the matter without taking any action as to Mr. Morrison.
