Dear Mr. Cannon:

As detailed in the attached letter, the Commission, on December 1, 2009, found reason to believe that Cannon for Congress ("Committee") and Lynn Gilbert, in his official capacity as Treasurer, violated 2 U.S.C. § 441a(f) and 11 C.F.R. §§ 102.9(e)(3), 110.1(b)(3), and 110.2(b)(3). On December 15, 2009, we notified Mr. Gilbert of the Commission's findings, but were informed that he no longer serves as the Committee's treasurer, and that you have assumed that role. While Mr. Gilbert filed a resignation letter with the Commission on May 21, 2009, the Committee has not yet filed an amended Statement of Organization, and therefore the change of treasurers is not official. Nonetheless, we are contacting you to ensure that the Committee receives notice of the Commission's findings.

Enclosed please find the letter and documents originally sent to Mr. Gilbert. We look forward to your response.
