RE: Complaint against VOLPac (second letter - first letter dated December 3, 2009)

Dear Sir or Madam:

It is my belief that Volunteer PAC/The Tennessee State Victory Fund (VOLPac) violated Federal Election Laws or Commission Regulations by refusing to refund a donation when notified that it was an illegal contribution as required according to Title 11 CFR 103.

On or about October 25, 2004, VOLPac received a contribution in the amount of \$5,000 in the form of a check signed by Vestrice Farrell. This check was drawn on a joint account titled in the name of Vestrice Holifield Farrell and George Farrell. I, Vestrice Farrell, DID NOT SIGN THE CHECK. On or about November 11, 2009, Ms. Farrell attempted to contact the individuals associated with the recently closed VOLPac to request a return of the illegal \$5,000 contribution received in her name.

Attempts to reach Ms. Dawn Perkerson, Treasurer of VOLPac (as indicated by FEC reports) by phone or mail were unsuccessful. According to the Federal Election Commission, it accepted a termination report for VOLPac dated August 19, 2009. Previously submitted to this office by Vestrice Farrell was a copy of the envelope returned by the United States Postal Service. The envelope was addressed to VOLPac using the address listed in FEC records

Ms. Farrell then contacted the office of former United States Senate Majority Leader, the Honorable Dr. William H. Frist. The reply of his office was that as VOLPac was closed, it was unable to provide a refund.

VOLPac was notified that it received an illegal contribution on November 19, 2009. Thirty days has passed and that entity has not provided a refund as required when it is notified of an illegal political contribution. It is my understanding that the FEC does not have a statute of limitations on the refund of illegal campaign contributions.

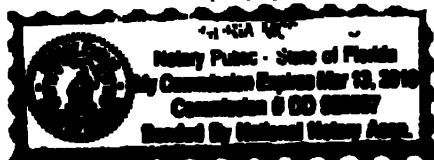

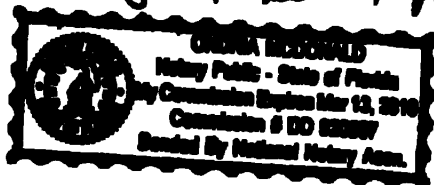
