On February 23, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified you of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On May 21, 2010, based upon the information contained in the complaint, the Commission decided that there is no reason to believe you violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, the Commission decided to dismiss the complaint and closed its file in this matter.
