
Thank you for your assistance by phone with regard to the above-referenced matter. I very much appreciate you taking my call and being so helpful.

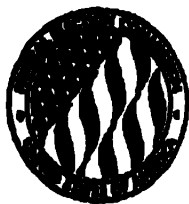
