On March 2, 2010, the Federal Election Commission notified the National Multi Housing Council PAC ("Committee") and you, as treasurer, of a complaint alleging violations of certain sections of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. On May 6, 2010, based upon the information contained in the complaint, and information provided by the Committee and you, as treasurer, the Commission decided that there is no reason to believe the Committee and you, as treasurer, violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended. Accordingly, the Commission decided to dismiss the complaint and closed its file in this matter.

Documents related to the case will be placed on the public record within 30 days. See Statement of Policy Regarding Disclosure of Closed Enforcement and Related Files, 68 Fed. Reg. 70,426 (Dec. 18, 2003). A copy of the dispositive General Counsel's Report is enclosed for your information.
