

At the breakfast, one of the many candidates to place literature on tables was Cory Ruth, the respondent, running for Georgia's 4<sup>th</sup> Congressional District. After looking over the push card the respondent had placed out, I noticed that they did not say who paid for them. Ten days latter, on the 16<sup>th</sup> of February, the respondent was at a DeKalb Young Republican meeting. He handed out the push cards again. And as with the first card, it still did not have disclaimer on it. Finally, upon going to the respondent's web-site, there is no disclaimer on it either. It is my understanding that all campaign advertising, to include push cards and web-sites, are required to have the name of the campaign committee, and disclaimer. I have included one of the push cards in question for your evaluation. Thank you for reviewing this matter.

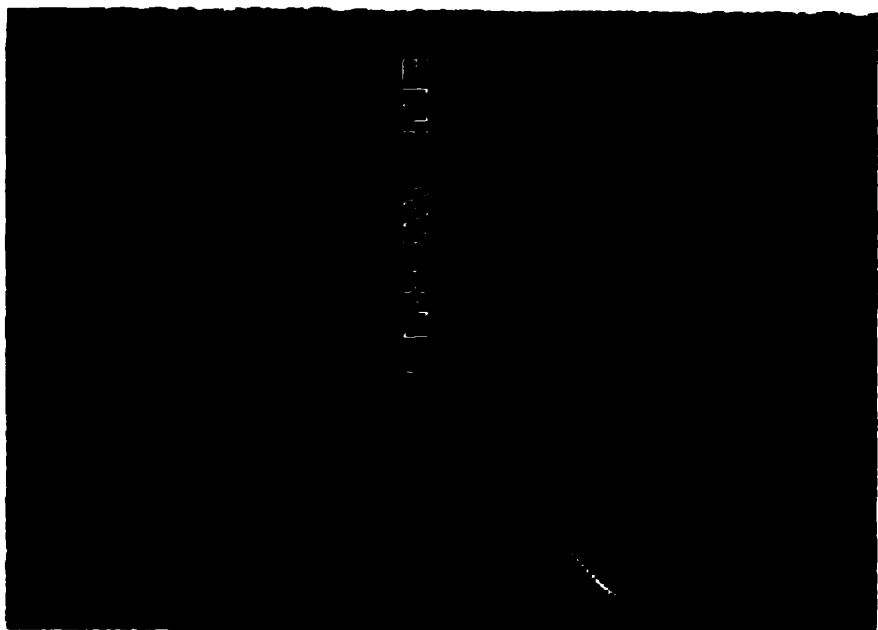
