COMPLAINT

1. Johnathan C. Gay brings this complaint before the Federal Election Commission ("FEC") seeking an immediate investigation and enforcement action against Rand Paul for U.S. Senate for distinct and serious violations of the Federal Election Campaign Act ("FECA").

Complainant

2. Complainant Johnathan C. Gay is a citizen of the United States of America and a registered voter and resident of the Commonwealth of Kentucky. As a registered voter, Mr. Gay is entitled to receive information contained in reports of receipts and disbursements required by the FECA, 2 U.S.C. § 434(a)(2); 11 C.F.R. § 104.1. Mr. Gay is harmed when a candidate, political committee or other regulated entity fails to report campaign finance activity as required by the FECA. *See FEC v. Akins*, 524 U.S. 11, 19 (1998), *quoting Buckley v. Valeo*, 424 U.S. 1, 66-67 (1976) (political committees must disclose contributors and disbursements to help voters understand who provides which candidates with financial support). Mr. Gay is further harmed when the FEC fails to properly administer the FECA's reporting requirements, limiting its ability to review campaign finance information.

Respondent

3. Rand Paul for U.S. Senate is the principal campaign committee of candidate for the United States Senate Rand Paul and, as such, is subject to the jurisdiction of the FEC. 2 U.S.C. § 431(5).

Violations and Recitation of Supporting Facts

COUNT I: FAILURE TO DISCLOSE COORDINATED COMMUNICATIONS

4. Rand Paul for U.S. Senate failed to disclose in any of its FEC Reports certain in-kind contributions, in the form of coordinated communications. See Rand Paul for Senate, FEC Form 3, filed October 14, 2009 and January 28, 2010 (attached hereto as Exhibit A).

5. FEC regulations require that a coordinated communication, including one that solicits for and promotes and supports a particular candidate, must be reported as in-kind contributions. See, 11 C.F.R. § 109.21 and 11 C.F.R. § 104.3(a)-(b).

6. Rand Paul for U.S. Senate has failed to disclose any in-kind contributions in violation of FEC regulations in the following instances: (i) Congressman Ron Paul's e-mail solicitations; (ii) COAST mailer and e-mail solicitation; and (iii) www.randpaulgraphs.com.

7. At least five (5) e-mail solicitations by Congressman Ron Paul or his principal campaign committee/authorized committee (11 C.F.R. § 100.5) requesting campaign contributions for Rand Paul for U.S. Senate far exceed simply endorsing Rand Paul, as they clearly (i) promote events and fundraisers, (ii) ask for monetary donations to Rand Paul or his principal campaign committee, and (iii) promote and support Rand Paul to the detriment of his opponents in the 2010 Kentucky U.S. Senate race. The five e-mails in question were dated and sent on June 4, 2009, June 15, 2009, September 22, 2009, December 14, 2009 and December 15, 2009 (attached hereto as Exhibit B). Additional evidence demonstrating a clear promotion in coordination with Ron Paul is found at: <http://rallyfortherepublicans.eventbrite.com> and in the e-mails sent in promotion of the event listed therein (attached hereto as Exhibit C). All of these e-mails and communications are obvious solicitations, endorsements, and promotions for Rand Paul or his principal campaign committee. One e-mail specifically instructs recipients to

contribute to Rand Paul's September 22, 2009 "moneybomb" on-line, day-long fundraiser, and two other e-mails specifically instruct recipients to contribute to Rand Paul's December 16, 2009 "moneybomb" on-line, day-long fundraiser. The e-mails were sent, upon information and belief, to Congressman Ron Paul's own list of contributors. If so, these actions would also constitute an impermissible use by Rand Paul for U.S. Senate of a contributors list for solicitation of campaign contributions. See AO 1979-3. No in-kind contributions have been disclosed by Rand Paul for U.S. Senate relating to these coordinated communications with Congressman Ron Paul. These failures to disclose demonstrate that, with respect to these issues, Rand Paul for U.S. Senate violated, at a minimum, 11 C.F.R. § 109.21.

8. The organization Citizens Organized Against Additional Spending and Taxes ("COAST") sent a mailing on behalf of Rand Paul on or about August 3, 2009 (attached hereto as Exhibit D). This mailing, in the form of a letter and enclosures, asked for pledges of support for Rand Paul and included a reply envelope directed to Rand Paul for U.S. Senate's primary campaign address of "1332 Andrea Street, Bowling Green, KY 42104." This address is the address on FEC Form 3 as well as the listed address on the Rand Paul for U.S. Senate's official website www.randpaul2010.com. The coordinated communication between COAST and Rand Paul for U.S. Senate is ~~over~~ upon taking notice that the return address for COAST listed on the actual mailing is identical to the Rand Paul for U.S. Senate's campaign address. In addition, COAST later sent e-mail solicitations, including one on December 16, 2009, to its contributor list supporting Rand Paul for U.S. Senate and instructing recipients to contribute to Rand Paul's December 16, 2009 "moneybomb" on-line, day-long fundraiser (e-mail attached hereto as Exhibit E). No in-kind contributions have been disclosed by Rand Paul for U.S. Senate relating to these coordinated communications with COAST. These failures to disclose demonstrate that,

with respect to these issues, Rand Paul for U.S. Senate violated, at a minimum, 11 C.F.R. § 109.21.

9. The website www.randpaulgraphs.com provides real time updates of contributions to the Rand Paul for U.S. Senate campaign. The website is developed by someone who, upon information and belief, is not an employee of the campaign (see documents attached hereto as Exhibit F). The content of the randpaulgraphs website is directly coordinated with the Rand Paul for U.S. Senate campaign. As an example, during the various "moneybomb" fundraisers, this website provided real time updates of contributions to the Rand Paul for U.S. Senate campaign. Furthermore, the campaign manager for Rand Paul for U.S. Senate, David Adams, frequently posts links to both the randpaulgraphs website and the website www.randsteaparty.com on his Facebook and Twitter accounts promoting the websites (see documents attached hereto as Exhibit G). No in-kind contributions have been disclosed by Rand Paul for U.S. Senate relating to these coordinated communications. This failure to disclose demonstrates that, with respect to this issue, Rand Paul for U.S. Senate violated, at a minimum, 11 C.F.R. § 109.21. Additional improper coordinated activity between Rand Paul for U.S. Senate and certain 501(c)(4) entities is set forth below in Count III, 15(x).

COUNT II: FAILURE TO MAKE APPROPRIATE PAYMENTS/REIMBURSEMENTS

10. There are at least two instances of the Rand Paul for U.S. Senate campaign failing to disclose on its FEC Reports where it reimbursed or paid expenses as required under FEC regulations (11 C.F.R. § 102.9; 11 C.F.R. part 104): (i) paying rent to Alchemy, LLC; and (ii) reimbursing expenses to Owensboro Dermatology PSC.

11. The Rand Paul for U.S. Senate campaign physical headquarters (as cited in paragraph 8 above) is owned by a company named "Alchemy, LLC." Alchemy, LLC is Rand

Paul's holding company for his rental properties (demonstrative documents attached hereto as Exhibit H). The FEC Reports filed by Rand Paul for U.S. Senate (and attached as Exhibit A to this Complaint) fail to indicate that any rent is being paid by Rand Paul for U.S. Senate to Alchemy, LLC. This failure to disclose this economic arrangement violates FEC regulations.

12. Owensboro Dermatology PSC distributed a mailer and hosted a reception with Rand Paul on September 1, 2009 (mailer attached hereto as Exhibit I). No evidence of reimbursement of expenses to Owensboro Dermatology is found in the Rand Paul for U.S. Senate FEC Reports. This omission is in violation of FEC regulations.

COUNT III: FAILURE TO CONTAIN THE PROPER DISCLAIMERS

13. Rand Paul for U.S. Senate failed to include the proper disclaimers required by the FEC on numerous campaign materials it sent or placed in the public domain (see documents attached hereto as Exhibit J).

14. Federal law requires that communications on behalf of the candidate or his campaign must contain certain disclaimers. See, i.e., 2 U.S.C. § 441d; 11 C.F.R. § 110.11.

15. Rand Paul for U.S. Senate has failed to include the proper disclaimers on the following campaign materials in violation of FEC regulations: (i) two mass mailing pieces from Rand Paul lack the required disclaimer on the first page and fail to list the required financial disclaimer on the contribution/reply form; (ii) a newspaper advertisement dated December 12, 2009 overtly supporting Rand Paul over other candidates lacks the required disclaimer; (iii) an August 3, 2009 COAST mailer and a December 16, 2009 COAST e-mail solicitation lack required disclaimers; (iv) the www.randpaulgraphs.com and www.randsteaparty.com websites and related Twitter and Facebook communications from Rand Paul for U.S. Senate campaign manager, David Adams, regarding those websites lack the required disclaimers; (v) an

Owensboro Dermatology mailer/invitation lacks the required disclaimer; (vi) robocalls made on January 22, 2010 and February 26, 2010 by Rand Paul lack the required disclaimer; (vii) a radio advertisement made and narrated by Rand Paul lacks the required disclaimer; (viii) a television advertisement made on behalf of Rand Paul lacks the required disclaimer as it clearly indicates that "Rand Paul for U.S. Senate" approved the advertisement instead of the candidate himself; (ix) a January 26, 2010 e-mail communication from "Andy Demers, Political Director" sent from an e-mail address for "Rand Paul, US Senate Committee" lacks the required disclaimer; and (x) a March 2, 2010 e-mail communication from David Adams to "Campaign for Liberty" contributors or members promoting a March 23, 2010 "Give Me Liberty Money Bomb" lacks the required disclaimers and further violates FEC regulations as Rand Paul for U.S. Senate is colluding with the 501(c)(4) entity "Campaign for Liberty." Copies of these materials are all attached hereto as Exhibit J.

16. These documents demonstrate that various required disclaimers were not included on numerous campaign materials and Rand Paul for U.S. Senate violated, at a minimum, 2 U.S.C. § 441d and 11 C.F.R. § 110.11.

Conclusion

Johnathan C. Gay requests that the Federal Election Commission conduct an investigation into these allegations, declare the Respondent to have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act and applicable FEC regulations, impose sanctions appropriate to these violations, and take such further action as may be deemed appropriate.



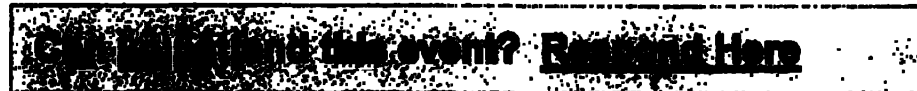

Most often, when we write you a letter about someone, we're writing about their votes for higher taxes, or other ways in which politicians sell out the taxpayers.

Today, we're writing about something a little different.

Some men and women in public life go so far above and beyond as heroes of the taxpayers, that they deserve to be recognized.

One of those very special few is Dr. Rand Paul.

That's why today, Citizens Organized Against Additional Spending and Taxes is excited to bestow the Taxpayer Defender Award upon Dr. Rand Paul for his fifteen years of leading the fight for lower taxes in Kentucky.

Rand Paul founded the grassroots action group Kentucky Taxpayers United in 1994.

Dr. Paul's coalition of taxpayers produces and distributes a highly respected and respected rating of the state legislature each year.

Every single legislator is ranked on tax and spending issues each session. These rankings have then in turn been used to inform voters who stand up for them against the Big Government allies in Frankfort.

These ratings and votes have often been used by groups and candidates to unseat liberal state legislators.

For example, in Brett Beekun's first race for the State

Senate, Rand Paul KTU helped persuade Brett to sign the pledge.

His opponent refused and KTU placed targeted radio ads in the final days of the campaign.

Guthrie's challenger called and complained that he'd never received the pledge. KTU produced a signed mail receipt with the candidate's wife's signature. With 24 hours to go until the election, the candidate capitulated and signed the pledge and the ads were pulled. Guthrie won the race by 124 votes.

Many state legislative races were won by using the Taxpayer Scorecard in campaigns.

Dr. Paul developed the Scorecard to provide a rating of state legislators on their voting record on tax and spending issues.

One candidate, Paul Marcotte of Northern KY, produced a campaign brochure headlining that his opponent got a ZERO from Kentucky Taxpayers United. Paul Marcotte won that race and served several terms in Frankfort.

In addition to his efforts with KTU, Rand Paul has also been a frequent guest in the media, including on Kentucky Tonight with Bill Goodman and has become a well known political analyst because of his work on the Taxpayer Pledge.

Some of the media elite, doing the bidding of the Big Government liberals, have criticized Dr. Paul for his "absolutist" stand on raising taxes.

Rand has responded that, "if we conclude that government is too big, we may be in favor of raising taxes?" Rand Paul reminds the media that there are many absolutes worth defending, including the first amendment. He never backs down from defending Kentucky Taxpayers.

The same way many of us believe that even a little censorship is wrong, many of us in the Tax movement believe that government has grown so incredibly large that any call to increase taxes is wrong.

Particularly, since even stable rates continue to provide an increased revenue. In Kentucky, the state's revenue has increased

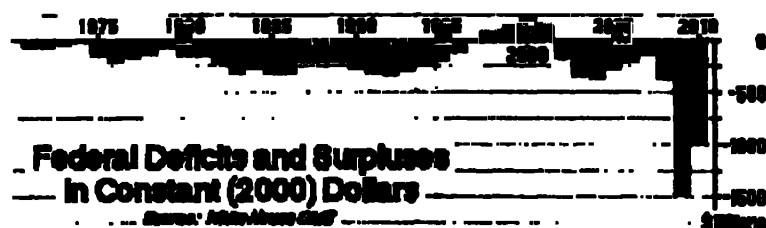
What is possibly most shocking about these events is the number of supposed leaders in the Republican party who back these structural attacks on the constitution and on our liberties.

I'm not a career politician. I'm an eye surgeon in Bowling Green, KY. I'm a small businessman. And I don't intend to become a politician for life. I believe that citizens should serve for a while and then return to live under the laws they create. I believe in term limits.

I'm a lifelong, many-generation Republican. At 13, I attended the national Republican Convention in 1976 when my father was one of only four Republican Congressmen to endorse Ronald Reagan.



Our country is drowning in a sea of debt. This year the debt will be 13% of GNP. Federal Spending will be 28% of GNP. Both are at historic highs. Many say that future generations will pay for this debt. But the danger is even more imminent.

To pay for the debt, we doubled the monetary base last year. Through fractional reserve banking, that base can multiply another ten-fold as it leaks into the economy.

We may begin to pay for this massive debt in the near future through significant inflation. I predict we will see prices rising as fast as they did in 1979 or worse within two years.

If you are like me, frustrated by years of Republicans telling us they will balance the budget and then going off to Washington and voting for the same pork barrel programs the Democrats give us, consider supporting my run for office.

There are two ways a Republican can win a general election in KY. First, you can give up your principles and run to the center: adopt the Democrat platform and promise that you can get even more federal projects than the Democrats. Or, you can stay true to your principles and present our ideas and platform in a way that appeals to independents and moderates.

We may lose many of these independents by appearing not to care or act in a fiscally responsible way. The public sees us as being in favor of tax cuts but not being in favor of or rising for expenditures in federal spending.

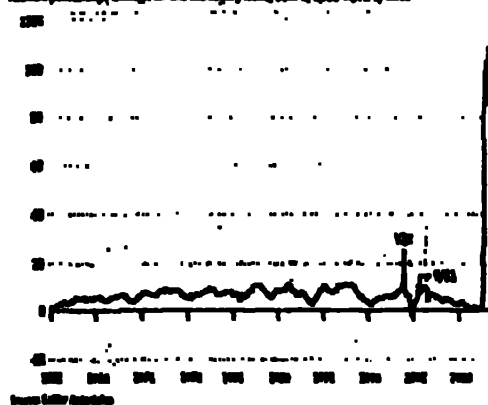
Many independents are simply frustrated fiscal conservatives who no longer believe that Republicans will vote for balanced budgets.

Most often, when we write you a letter about someone, we're writing about their votes for higher taxes, or other ways in which politicians sell out the taxpayers.

Today, we're writing about something a little different.

Some men and women in public life go so far above and beyond as heroes of the taxpayers, that they deserve to be recognized.

One of those very special few is Dr. Rand Paul.

That's why today, Citizens Organized Against Additional Spending and Taxes is excited to bestow the Taxpayer Defender Award upon Dr. Rand Paul for his fifteen years of leading the fight for lower taxes in Kentucky.

Rand Paul founded the grassroots action group Kentucky Taxpayers United in 1994.

Dr. Paul's coalition of taxpayers produces and distributes a highly respected and referenced ranking of the state legislators each year.

Every single legislator is ranked on tax and spending issues each session. These rankings have then in turn been used to inform voters who stands up for them against the Big Government allies in Frankfort.

These ratings and votes have often been used by groups and candidates to unseat liberal state legislators.

For example, in Brett Guthrie's first race for the State

Senate, Rand Paul KTU helped persuade Brett to sign the pledge.

His opponent refused and KTU placed targeted radio ads in the final days of the campaign.

Guthrie's challenger called and complained that he'd never received the pledge. KTU produced a signed mail receipt with the candidate's wife's signature. With 24 hours to go until the election, the candidate capitulated and signed the pledge and the ads were pulled. Guthrie won the race by 124 votes.

Many state legislative races were won by using the Taxpayer Scorecard in campaigns.

Dr. Paul developed the Scorecard to provide a rating of state legislators on their voting record on tax and spending issues.

One candidate, Paul Marcotte of Northern KY, produced a campaign brochure headlining that his opponent got a ZERO from Kentucky Taxpayers United. Paul Marcotte won that race and served several terms in Frankfort.

In addition to his efforts with KTU, Rand Paul has also been a frequent guest in the media, including on Kentucky Tonight with Bill Goodman and has become a well known political analyst because of his work on the Taxpayer Pledge.

Some of the media elite, doing the bidding of the Big Government liberals, have criticized Dr. Paul for his "absolutist" stand on raising taxes.

Rand has responded that, "if we conclude that government is too big, how can we be in favor of raising taxes?" Rand Paul reminds the media that there are many absolutes worth defending, including the first amendment. He never backs down from defending Kentucky Taxpayers.

The same way many of us believe that even a little censorship is wrong, many of us in the Tax movement believe that government has grown so incredibly large that any call to increase taxes is wrong.
