I am writing to file a complaint against Mr. Art Robinson who is running for the Republican nomination in Oregon's 4th Congressional District.

To date, Mr. Robinson has failed to file a Statement of Candidacy and Statement of Organization with the Federal Election Commission for the 2010 election cycle. Yet Mr. Robinson appears to have well-exceeded the \$5,000 threshold for contributions and expenditures. On April 3, 2010, Mr. Robinson himself told the *Grants Pass Daily Courier* that his campaign had raised over \$110,000. There is also reason to believe that the Robinson for Congress campaign is accepting illegal contributions from prohibited sources.

Timeline of Contributions and Expenditures Exceeding \$5,000 Threshold
On March 9, 2010, Mr. Robinson filed a Statement of Candidacy to run for Oregon's Fourth Congressional District with the Oregon Secretary of State [see Item #1].

Since he has filed, Mr. Robinson's campaign has received well over the \$5,000 threshold. On April 3, 2010, Mr. Robinson himself told the *Grants Pass Daily Courier* that his campaign, "has raised about \$112,000." [see Item #2].

In addition to raising more than \$5,000, Mr. Robinson's campaign has exceeded the expenditure threshold as well. Two days after filing as a candidate, he wrote a check to the Secretary of State for \$2500 to place a statement in the Oregon Voter's Pamphlet [see Item #3].

On March 13, 2010, Mr. Robinson released the "first iteration" of his campaign website that features the FEC required disclaimer claiming the site was paid for an authorized by, "Art Robinson for Congress" [see Item #4].

On March 31, 2010, Mr. Robinson and his campaign team distributed a four-page color glossy campaign brochure, campaign buttons, and campaign lawn signs at a Republican Candidates Forum in Roseburg, Oregon [see Item #3 and photo #31]. And in the first week in April 2010, Mr. Robinson's campaign mailed the four-page glossy campaign brochure to an undisclosed list of nonaffiliated registered voters in Oregon [see Item #5, #6, #7, and #8].

Contributions from Prohibited Sources

The Democratic Party of Oregon believes that Mr. Robinson has received and accepted in-kind contributions from the Oregon Institute of Science and Medicine, Althouse Press, and the newsletter *Access to Energy* -- all entities operated by Mr. Robinson.

Access to Energy is a monthly newsletter written and printed by Mr. Robinson and sent to thousands of paid subscribers. In the March 2010 edition of the newsletter, Mr. Robinson included the following piece about his congressional campaign and asked for donations:

"We should be able to raise the necessary campaign funds -- if we start well. Early donations will be the most valuable. We need to reach the voters as quickly as possible. Soon, the media will be evaluating our effort on the basis of how much money has been contributed -- and by how many people.

"Please help us! The maximum permitted individual contribution is \$2,400, but even \$1 contributions -- especially early ones -- are very helpful." [see Item #9]

According to his website, Mr. Robinson's campaign is using Post Office Box 1250 in Cave Junction, Oregon, for campaign donations. This is the same PO Box used by both *Access to Energy* and Althouse Press since at least 1998 [see Items #10, #11, and #12]. In addition, he is using the fax number for the Oregon Institute of Science and Medicine to receive faxed contributions [see Items #13 and #14].

I have reason to believe the Robinson campaign headquarters is the same as the Oregon Institute of Science and Medicine. The mailing address provided to the Oregon Secretary of State by his campaign is 2251 Dick George Road in Cave Junction, Oregon. The Oregon Institute of Science and Medicine lists that same address as its primary address on IRS forms and with the Oregon Secretary of State Corporations Division [see Items #1 and #15 and #16].

Due to the seriousness of these apparent violations, we request the FEC investigate these matters immediately. Mr. Robinson's campaign has already raised and spent over \$5,000 and should have filed a committee with the FEC weeks ago. In addition, his apparent use corporate or non-profit resources to further his campaign, constitutes a serious violation of the law. We



respectfully request a prompt resolution to this matter prior to the Oregon Pre-Primary filing due to the FEC on May 6th.

I look forward to a prompt resolution to this matter.

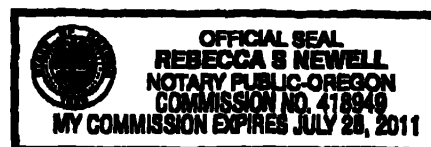

Robinson seeking DeFazio's seat

For the past 30 years Art Robinson has studied molecular biology and aging, and written about energy while raising six children on his sheep and hay ranch in the Illinois Valley.

Robinson, 67, founder of the Oregon Institute of Science and Medicine and former research partner with Nobel Prize winner Linus Pauling, is running for the District 4 congressional seat held by Democrat Peter DeFazio for the past quarter century.

He said he couldn't sit back and watch any more.

"I think my country is in trouble," said Robinson, who earned his PhD at University of California San Diego. "It gets to the point you want to do something. It was a family decision to do it."

His opponent in the May Republican primary is Jaynee Gormond of Roseburg, who was soundly beaten by DeFazio in 2008.

The Fourth District covers the portion of Josephine County outside of greater Grants Pass, and includes about one-third of county voters.

So far Robinson has raised about \$112,000 and has made a few local speaking engagements.

"I'm not running against Gormond. I'm running against DeFazio," he said. "I hope people decide I'm the better candidate."

Robinson and his wife, Lauren, moved to the Illinois Valley in the late 1970s, after he and Pauling had a falling out. She died in 1998, leaving Robinson to raise six children.

Two of the children now are veterinarians, another is a scientist who works alongside his father, and the three youngest are pursuing doctoral degrees at Oregon State University, and still coming home on weekends to work the ranch.

Robinson's research facility operates on about \$300,000 a year, all from donations. He also makes some money from writing the newsletter "Access to Energy," and from a home-schooling curriculum developed with his own children.

He believes in free enterprise, less government intervention and is among the leaders in the scientific community who don't believe the notion of human-caused global warming.

"There is tremendous damage being done to our country by an acceleration of government intervention," he said. "Since Obama was elected it's been astonishing."

Robinson argues that the country's tilt toward alternative energy makes no sense, that civilization's only cost-effective way to produce large amounts of energy is burning hydrocarbons and nuclear power.

"DeFazio voted against cap-and-trade because he said it didn't go far enough," Robinson said. "This is the way to completely destroy our economy. The man doesn't seem to understand that."

In cap-and-trade, businesses that pollute are capped to a certain amount unless they buy credits from entities that pollute less. It hasn't been passed into law yet.

Robinson wrote an editorial piece for the Wall Street Journal on global warming 23 years ago, and twice has distributed a petition signed by scientists who don't believe in human-caused global warming.

"Al Gore said the science was settled, but we know that's not true. Science isn't done by a poll. All we were doing was demonstrating that it's not a consensus. And we got smeared all over the country," he said. "The movie ('An Inconvenient Truth') is fiction. I've never seen such a departure from the truth in my life."

Robinson believes current warming of the earth cannot be solely from human-caused emissions, nor is it much of a factor at all, because carbon dioxide is a minor component of the atmosphere.

He points out over the centuries carbon dioxide levels have risen and fallen right in line with temperature fluctuations — long before man was spewing out emissions — caused by solar changes.

"Oil simply cannot cause that much change," he said. "There is no experimental evidence showing human activity is warming the earth. Their entire argument rests on computer models."

Robinson faces Jaynee Gormond in the Republican primary. The winner of the primary will face Democratic incumbent Rep. Peter DeFazio on the November general election ballot.

power plants 30 years ago has cost \$10 trillion in electricity not generated, assuming a 1970s textbook projection of 900 more reactors, he said.

"We'd be swash in free energy."

He continued, "Higher taxes and higher regulations have stifled American industry. Because of our freedom, we used to produce more than we consume. Now we consume more than we produce, so we're going in debt."

Lyann Vanderlinden, an Illinois Valley rancher and Farm Bureau member like Robinson, said Robinson is the choice because "our industry and way of life is not being represented by incumbent Peter DeFazio."

"Art is no stranger to public speaking at scientific and public gatherings, and visiting Congress people in their Washington offices. He has many friends on a national level who are very knowledgeable in practical politics," Vanderlinden said. "He will be more than a match for DeFazio, and a boon to farmers, ranchers and natural resource producers."

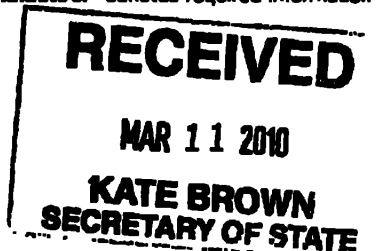

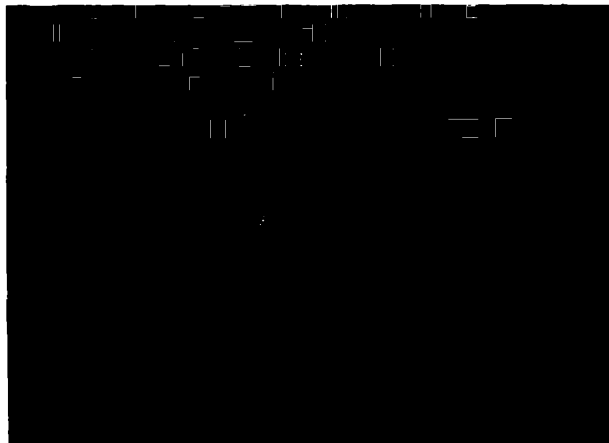

Freedom Falters in the 1970s

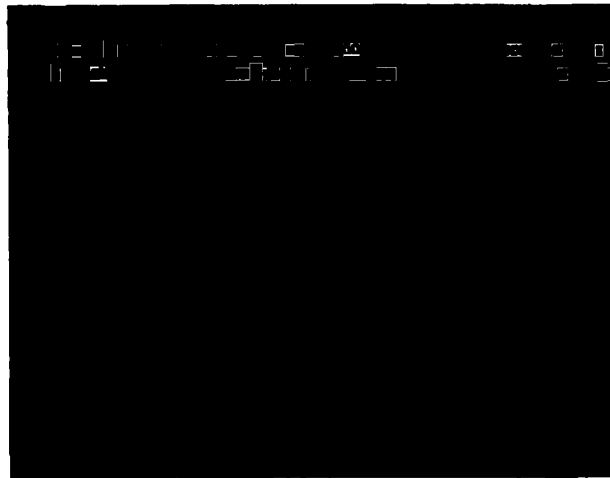
America is in trouble. Washington is flooded by career politicians, pursuing personal goals rather than the best interests of our country. They trade their votes for power to those who bid the highest.

Art enjoyed a very different life. The Lord raised the children, Art ran errands, and the seven Robinsons grew up on the farm together.

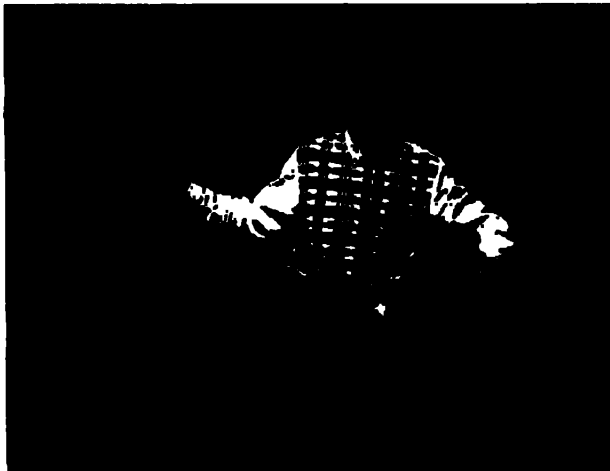

Based on a scientific review article they authored entitled "Environmental Effects of Increased Atmospheric Carbon Dioxide," the Robinsons circulated a petition by mail that has been signed by more than 31,000 Americans with university degrees in science - urging the government not to ration and tax energy supplies on the basis of the scientifically invalid claims of human-caused global warming.

When colleagues urged us to update our 10-year-old review article "Environmental Effects of Increased Carbon Dioxide" by Zachary Robinson, Willie Sun, Salia Sultana, and me and to re-run the petition project that had garnered 17,000 signatures in 1999-1998, Noah and I had various misgivings. A review of the research literature and completion of the petition work would cost us at least six months away from our research and other goals - and probably longer. Moreover, the necessary financial support from readers of Access to Energy and signers of the petition placed a heavy responsibility upon us. Neither the scientific work nor the petition could be delayed. It was entirely ours to do.

We do not want to do this, but the daunting argument undermines it. Neither of us has served in the U.S. military. We decided that we owed that to our country. With the goals of our work in medical research, education, and emergency preparedness may meet our obligations there, but we cannot avoid: while these scientists, many other productive Americans - dreams that will never be realized if our country's supplies of energy are destroyed and its people economically embowed.

So, the result was a new, slightly enhanced "Environmental Effects of Increased Carbon Dioxide" by Noah Robinson, Willie Sun, and me - extended by Internet and other means to be (as was the original review) the most read scientific article on this subject - and 32,000 signatures by Americans with education in physical science, including more than 9,000 PhDs.

This day we launched the project over to volunteers and went back to work. The petition and review have proved significantly useful to those who fight the political battles on this issue. No single action will stop our enemies, but this is a vehicle.

Since then, we and our colleagues at Oilwatch have completed and published research on a problem ultimately linked to Al Gore's and Robinson's discovery: climate change. We have published research on deniers and we are now in a position of research and writing up for the last contribution to applied medical science that we have ever been privileged to make. This will be completed in 2010.

Can we do more against the enemies of our country? The answer turns out to be "yes" - but it involves a sad event. I am being required to abandon my cloth computer of about 30 years and buy a new one.

Tom Rath's "A Scientist Finds Independence" in the February 2001 American Spectator quotes us as saying, "It is time to complete about those who would do it. It is better to take some scientific matters to the courts than to let them go. It is self-satisfying to take action. Strong enough to reach goals. An enemy is not hostile, however, unless he is in that. Others. It is best to let them, unless they are hostile to one's field of specialization."

Well, we do lots of completing in Access to Energy, and the Petition Project is noticeable and often praised. Our enemies are, however, not hostile. Judging by the current spectacle in Washington, they are now attempting to find, desperate to find us off - not just our energy industry, but also our Constitution, our freedoms, and our way of life. In so far as work outside our specialty is concerned, we are early for from science and education. It requires, however, that one of the most important enemies of the environment is the powerful presence of refuting American energy under the name of "global warming" is one Peter DeFazio, the 12-term United States Congressman from Oregon District 4 in which we live. During 23 years in Congress, DeFazio has closely and effectively dropped away at American freedom. DeFazio's legislative record is a testament to his ability, except in 2008 when he received 82% against a lady from the Christiana Bots, who is now making the Republican nomination.

District 4 Republicans were supervising a typical candidate against DeFazio, but he suddenly withdrew from the race just before the final deadline - leaving DeFazio with a free ride to a 13th term, opposed only by a candidate with essentially no chance to beat him. Our family decided that the most realistic return of the money in Congress under the conditions that now prevail in Washington is unthinkable, so - I told against him. The price of victory is too much money. The general election is in seven months. This is a tough time, and we have a lot to learn and to do.

Fortunately, we have some excellent help. Our work on national issues has earned us many friends who are very knowledgeable in political politics. If our initial campaign is well done, many more such people will help.

Can "we" - I am the candidate, but everyone who helps is in this together - defeat DeFazio and rid Washington of the disaster? I am confident that the answer is yes, if we do our work quickly and well. In ordinary recent elections (governors elected our district in 2002), 40% of its voters voted against him in support of his challenger. Our candidacy is much better, and the Democrats are in serious and unusual trouble with the electorate.

We should be able to defeat DeFazio. Our message and debating skills are superior. The inherent dishonesty evident in his rhetoric and speeches is an advantage to him - against a candidate who fearlessly tells the truth. DeFazio is used to running against politicians. He is going to be astonished by us.

Can we finance the next campaign? DeFazio has a \$600,000 campaign fund that will undoubtedly spend, especially as the challenge to his leadership.

We should be able to raise the necessary campaign funds - if we start well. Early donations will be the most valuable. We need to reach the voters as quickly as possible. Soon, the media will be evaluating our effort on the basis of how much money has been contributed - and by how many people.

Quantitative measurement of deamidation in lens β B2-crystallin and peptides by direct electrospray ionization and fragmentation in a Fourier transform mass spectrometer

Abstract

Purpose: Deamidation of lens crystallins and specific deamidation sites have been suggested to be associated with aging and cataracts. However, these studies have been hindered by the lack of suitable quantitative methods of measurement of protein deamidation. Mass spectrometry is a method to quantitatively measure deamidation of proteins and peptides without prior sample preparation or separation in order to directly compare the amidated and deamidated forms. We have tested the hypothesis that the 19 mDa mass defect that distinguishes deamidated peptides and proteins from the ordinary natural isotopic species can be utilized for quantitative measurement of their rate and extent of deamidation. The measurement technique used was ion cyclotron resonance Fourier transform mass spectrometry (FTMS), along with no prior sample preparation or separation. The amidated and deamidated species were simultaneously separated from the sample by ion exchange chromatography and the peptides Glycylserine and Glycylalanine. FTMS measurements of lens proteins from a 1-month-old human donor were also carried out.

Methods: Wild type and mutant human eye lens β B2-crystallins with Glu122 replaced by Gly122 were produced in bacteria, and Glycylserine and Glycylalanine were synthesized by Merrifield solid-phase peptide synthesis. The peptides were deamidated in pH 7.4, 37.50 °C, 0.15 M Tris-HCl aqueous solution for 18 successive time intervals before analysis. Mutant and wildtype β B2-crystallin solutions at various concentrations were mixed and analyzed. The peptides were introduced by electrospray ionization into the ion cyclotron resonance FTMS. Two measurement procedures were demonstrated for the proteins. In the first, β B2-crystallin was introduced into the mass spectrometer by electrospray ionization and the +19 isotopic group was selectively introduced into the ICR mass analyzer, where 14 residue and 18 residue laser-induced fragments were separated and the extent of deamidation determined by mass defect analysis. In the second, β B2-crystallin was introduced into the mass spectrometer by electrospray ionization and the entire sample was fragmented by collision ionization before introduction into the ICR mass analyzer, where 14 residue fragments were separated and the extent of deamidation determined by mass defect analysis.

Results: The β B2-crystallin was shown to be a good quantitative measure upon extent of deamidation. Direct injection by electrospray ionization followed by ion selection and laser fragmentation or by collision fragmentation produced fragments of amidated and deamidated β B2-crystallin that were appropriate for FTMS quantitative analysis. The two peptides exhibited the expected four deamidation rate curves with acceptable precision.

Conclusions: Mass defect FTMS quantitative analysis of protein deamidation, as required for the first time herein and illustrated with β B2-crystallin, should prove quite useful. The procedure with no separation, chemically, enzymatic digestion, derivatization, and other procedures substantially add cost and time while degrading quantitative comparison of the amidated and deamidated forms. Mass defect FTMS is also well suited to quantitative deamidation rate studies of peptides. The substantial potential significance of this technique is evident, as example, for lens crystallins where it makes possible quantitative studies of age and disease-dependent deamidation that have heretofore been very difficult. This technique should allow convenient and reliable identification and quantitative measurement of specific deamidation sites that may play a role in aging and cataracts.

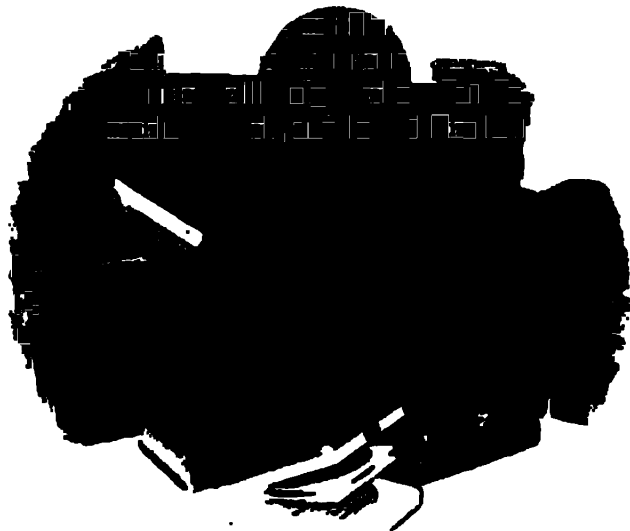

Art Robinson - and his scientific wife Laurelee - have left UCSD and founded an institute with Art's long-time friend and colleague Linus Pauling. They have originated a new discipline - now known as "metabolomics" - a revolutionary medical advance.

As President and Research Professor of their institute, Art assumes that their medical discoveries will soon be available to the American people. He is naive. The tentacles of Washington politicians have already reached into American medicine - choking off innovation.

By November 1982, they have 12-year-old Zachary, Noah 10, Arynne 8, twins Joshua and Bethany 6, and Matthew 18 months.

It is Armistice Day, November 11. President Reagan has made a wonderful speech. All of the Robinsons seem to have a stomach flu, but by morning, they are much better - except for Laurelee.

Laurelee is dead.

The report states that she died of acute idiopathic hemorrhagic pancreatitis - her pancreas releasing enzymes that punctured an artery. She was ill for 24 hours. She was 43 years old.

A silent, almost eerie calm settles upon the Robinson children. Their grief is deep, but it does not harm them. The loving hand of God quickens, it comforts, it gently leads. It is a living unseen.

A Scientist and Six Children

Art entered a very different life. The Lord raised the children, Art ran errands, and the seven Robinsons grew up on the farm together.

They completed the defense work - traveling cross country many times together, publishing tens of thousands of copies of instructions and books that FEMA distributed throughout the United States, and building civil defense displays purchased by the federal government and displayed to millions of Americans.

Without Laurelee, their home school became an example in self-learning, and Art and the children, with help from friends and colleagues, gradually developed a self-teaching curriculum and an array of children's books that they now publish.

More than 60,000 American children now use their curriculum for grades 1 through 12, and the six children have put each other through college and graduate school with this family business.

Zachary, Noah, Arynne, Bethany, and Matthew earned BS degrees in chemistry - Zachary, Noah, and Matthew completing those degrees in two years at college. Joshua earned a BS in mathematics.

Zachary and Arynne earned doctorates in veterinary medicine from Iowa State University. Noah earned his PhD in chemistry from Caltech - finishing in three years and publishing four papers in the *Proceedings of the National Academy of Sciences*. In 2010, Joshua, Bethany, and Matthew are graduate students at Oregon State University - all working to earn PhD degrees in nuclear engineering.

The seven Robinsons divided the work as needed, with some adjustments. After five years of one-course meals - twice a day, Art is permanently replaced in the kitchen by his hungry peers. Today the children still do their farm work on weekends home from school.

The whole family and their colleagues gradually built the Oregon Institute of Science and Medicine into a world-class laboratory for the study of human molecular clinics and biomedical research.

Their most recent publication involves a protein intimately involved in Alzheimer's and Parkinson's diseases. Robinson publications are highly respected and widely read by scientists throughout the world. One research publication - Art's favorite - is authored by all seven Robinsons. They all participated in the work.

The Robinsons love music and resurrect church pipe organs as a hobby. They have also republished most of the life's recordings of the great gospel singer George Beverly Shea - a project in which they have produced 27 CDs with more than 400 songs.

Art has written the pro-science, pro-technology, pro-free enterprise newsletter *Access to Energy* for 17 years, inheriting this work from scientist and refugee from Communism Petr Bockmann. *Access to Energy* is science for laymen in areas of interest in human affairs. One-third of the subscribers are scientists and engineers.
