

The Commission reminds you, that pursuant to 2 U.S.C. § 441d and C.F.R. § 110.11, concerning the use of appropriate disclaimers on television advertisements made in connection with the campaign, to take steps to ensure that your conduct is in compliance with the Act and Commission regulations.
