GENERAL COUNSEL'S REPORT

On August 4, 1978 the Commission found reason to believe that the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County, (hereinafter the Republican Committee) violated 2 U.S.C. §441b by accepting a corporate contribution from Milpitas Materials Company.

The Commission also found reason to believe that the Milpitas Materials Co. violated 2 U.S.C. §441b by making a corporate contribution to the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County.

The Office of General Counsel has received replies from both respondents verifying that the corporate contribution at issue here of \$200.00 made in 1976 was refunded by the Republican Committee in April of this year.

Additionally, the Republican Committee has assured the Office of General Counsel that "great care will be taken to screen each check prior to deposit" and also that their bookkeeping procedures are being revised to minimize the risk of receiving corporate contributions in the future.

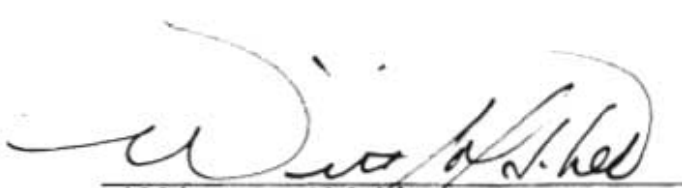

U.R.F.C.'s bookkeeping records are continually being revised to be as accurate as possible in reporting to State and Federal Election Commissions.

U.R.F.C. has two (2) separate bank account's. One of which can legally accept corporate contributions for donation to State and local candidates and the other account for contributions made by individuals for donation to federal candidates. Great care is taken to screen each check prior to deposit. The check in question was deposited into the wrong account (human error). Upon notification of the error from your office the check was returned. We have complied with the law and further pursuit of this matter would indicate an overstaffed department wasting my time and the taxpayers money.

GENERATION OF MATTER

This matter was referred to the Office of General Counsel from the Reports Analysis Division on the basis of information disclosed on the reports filed by the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County.

SUMMARY OF ALLEGATIONS

That the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County accepted \$200.00 in contributions from a corporation, the Milpitas Materials Co., in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b. That the Milpitas Materials Co. made one contribution to the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County in violation of 2 U.S.C. § 441b.

PRELIMINARY LEGAL ANALYSIS

During the review of quarterly 1977 Reports of Receipts and Expenditures of the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County, the Division of Reports Analysis discovered one corporate contribution of \$200.00 dated November 29, 1977 from Milpitas Materials Co. Since this corporation has no political action committee registered with the Commission, the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County was contacted on April 3, 1978 and advised to refund this contribution.

A response received on April 18, 1978 indicated that the Committee had refunded this contribution and enclosed a report to document the refund.

Since this situation is analogous to many of the audit generated MURS concerning § 441b contributions and meets the policy thresholds established therewith, the Office of General Counsel recommends that this case be treated in a like manner and that reason to believe a § 441b violation has occurred be found.

RECOMMENDATION

1. Find reason to believe the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b by accepting a corporate contribution from Milpitas Materials Co.
2. Find reason to believe the Milpitas Materials Co. violated 2 U.S.C. § 441b by making a corporate contribution to the United Republican Finance Committee of Santa Clara County.
