To whom it may concern,

I would like to bring to your attention certain campaign violations committed by the Joe Walsh for Congress Committee, Inc. ID #C00473579 at P.O. Box 56, 830 W, Route 22, Lake Zurich, IL 60047. There have been multiple violations on record thus far. The violations are as follows:

- There has been extensive legal counsel representing the campaign committee that has not been disclosed or paid for by the committee of Joe Walsh for Congress. Documentation of proof of use for counsel is attached. Also, besides attached documents there is also questionable use of law firm to incorporate the said committee.
- There was auto calls made on February 1, 2010 for the sole purpose of the campaign by a Bryan Javor of Michenry. He owns a business that does auto calling for multiple uses and on that date did multiple auto calls for the said campaign. See attached documentation. Mr. Javor in addition made numerous auto calls paid for by Bruce Donnelly of Barrington. Which the campaign provided phone numbers to Mr. Javor for Mr. Donnelly to assist in the auto calls to increase Joe Walsh's name ID and get out the vote effort. None of these calls were ever disclosed, in-kind or paid for by the Joe Walsh for Congress Committee, Inc as per election laws require.
- In regard to Bryan Javor and the auto calls. There was also a poll done by Mr. Javor which I believe was paid for by Christopher Golsner (A primary opponent of Mr. Walsh). The polling results were handed over to the Walsh campaign prior to the results being given to the paying customer. Once again there is no disclosure in the Joe Walsh for Congress Committee, Inc filings.
- Lastly to my knowledge, there is no record of payment to Dock's Bar and Grill in Wauconda Illinois where the February 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2010 election night party was held. There was the cost of the room rental, along with appetizers for the evening, plus the candidate prep room upstairs that was not disclosed as either being paid for or through an in-kind contribution to the campaign.
- I also believe that Mr. Walsh received large amounts of money over the \$2400 maximum from his family that was filtered into the campaign through multiple donors and questionable book keeping by his campaign treasurer and wife Helene Miller-Walsh. There is confirmation on this, but individual is reluctant to release information of checks and routing numbers due to fear of prosecution on his behalf. If information becomes available on this matter I will forward to you immediately.
