Re: Philip Liberatore, Liberatore for Congress Committee, and Philip L. Liberatore, CPA

Dear Ms. Duncan:

Pursuant to 2 USC § 437g(a)(1) and 11 CFR § 111.4, please accept this letter as a Complaint against Philip Liberatore ("Liberatore"), Liberatore for Congress Committee ("the Committee"), and Philip L. Liberatore, CPA ("the Corporation") for operating in violation of the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended (the "Act"), and Federal Election Commission ("FEC" or "Commission") regulations. More specifically, Liberatore, the Committee, and the Corporation have violated FEC regulations by accepting and making, respectively, impermissible in-kind corporate contributions. Additionally, Liberatore and the Committee have failed to disclose the illegal contributions on the Committee's April Quarterly Report ("the Report"), and the Corporation has impermissibly used corporate resources to facilitate contributions to the Committee.

I. Facts

Liberatore for Congress Committee is the principal campaign committee for Philip Liberatore, a candidate for the United States House of Representatives, campaigning to represent California's 42th Congressional District. The Committee's FEC Form 1 Statement of Organization was filed with the FEC on January 15, 2010. Liberatore's FEC Form 2 Statement of Candidacy was filed with the FEC on December 10, 2009.

Philip L. Liberatore, CPA is a professional corporation. The Corporation's website, located at <http://www.liberatorecpa.com/home.html>, states "Philip L. Liberatore, Certified Public Accountant is a professional corporation providing accounting, consulting and tax preparation services to business [sic] and individuals throughout Southern California." Liberatore is listed as President of the Corporation according to the Corporation's website. See <http://www.liberatorecpa.com/contact.html>.

On or about March 22, the Committee mailed a mail piece to an unknown class of recipients (hereinafter, "Campaign Mailer"). See Attachment 1 for copies of the front of the envelope and the contents of the Campaign Mailer. The front of the envelope has a logo in the top left corner that says "Phil Liberatore - Conservative for U.S. Congress - June 8, 2010", and the words "URGENT ELECTION INFORMATION" are also printed

on the front of the envelope. The postage used is obviously from a mail permit. The number printed for the postage in the top right corner of the envelope is 02 1A 0004610690. The envelope contained a letter dated March 22, 2010 and signed by Liberatore asking for support in his campaign to represent the 42nd Congressional District in California, as well as a reply card and an invitation, both soliciting money for Liberatore and the Committee.

On or about April 26, 2010, the Corporation mailed a letter to an unknown class of recipients (hereinafter, the "Corporate Mailer"). See Attachment 2 for a copy of the front of the envelope. The front of the envelope has the following printed in the top left corner: "Philip L. Liberatore, CPA - A Professional Corporation - 16890 Valley View Avenue, La Mirada, California 90638-5824." Similar to the Campaign Mailer, a mail permit is used to provide the postage, and the number printed is 02 1A 0004610690. This is the same permit number as used for the Campaign Mailer. At the request of the recipient, we did not open the Corporate Mailer envelope and therefore cannot state what the envelope contained.

The Committee's April Quarterly Report, filed on April 19, 2010, does not include any disbursements reimbursing the Corporation for use of its mail permit, nor any inkind contribution from the Corporation for use of the mail permit.

II. Illegal Corporate Contributions

The Act and FEC regulations define contribution to include "any gift, subscription, loan, advance, or deposit of money or anything of value made by any person for the purpose of influencing any election for Federal office." 2 USC § 431(8)(A)(i), 11 CFR § 100.52(a). Corporations are prohibited from making contributions to federal political committees, and federal political committees are prohibited from knowingly accepting or receiving contributions made from the general treasury funds of corporations. 11 CFR § 114.2 (a), (d).

The Committee has clearly used the Corporation's mail permit to send the Campaign Mailer. The mail permit numbers used for the Campaign Mailer and the Corporate Mailer are exactly the same. The Campaign Mailer was sent on or about March 22, 2010, and thus the Report should certainly include any expenditures made or inkind contributions received by the Committee related to this mailing. The Report does not disclose any such disbursements or receipts.

By permitting the Corporation to pay the cost of the postage for the Campaign Mailer, Liberatore and the Committee have accepted a prohibited corporate inkind contribution. Similarly, the Corporation has made an illegal inkind contribution equal in amount to the cost of the postage for the Campaign Mailer.

III. Failure to Report Illegal In-kind Corporation Contribution

Once an individual becomes a candidate, his or her principal campaign committee must file quarterly reports. 11 CFR § 104.5(a). The principal campaign committee is required to completely and accurately disclose all receipts and all disbursements according to FEC Regulations. 11 CFR §§ 104.3(a)(3), (b)(2).

Regardless of whether the postage for the Campaign Mailer was funded by a prohibited in-kind corporate contribution from the Corporation or by a disbursement from the Committee to reimburse the Corporation, the Committee failed to report the cost of the postage on its April Quarterly Report. This is a violation of the Act and FEC Regulations for which the Committee should be cited.

IV. Corporate Facilitation of Contributions

Corporations are prohibited from using corporate resources to facilitate the making of contributions to a federal political committee other than the corporation's separate segregated fund. 11 CFR § 114.2(f)(1). Examples of "facilitating the making of contributions" include fundraising activities by corporations without proper reimbursement to the corporation within a commercially reasonable time for the use of corporate facilities or resources, as well as instances where the corporation provides materials, such as postage, for the purpose of transmitting or delivering contributions. 11 CFR §§ 114.2(f)(2)(i)(B), (ii).

The Corporation permitted Liberatore and the Committee to use its mail permit for fundraising activities, and the Report does not disclose that the Committee reimbursed the Corporation for the cost of the postage. Thus, the Corporation has provided the postage for the purpose of raising contributions for the Committee, and has clearly violated the prohibition against corporate facilitation of contributions.

IV. Conclusion

Upon information and belief, and based upon the facts relayed herein, Philip Liberatore, Liberatore for Congress Committee, and Philip L. Liberatore, CPA have violated the Federal Election Campaign Act of 1971, as amended, and Federal Election Commission Regulations. Accordingly, we respectfully request that the Commission conduct an immediate investigation into the violations outlined above and impose the maximum penalty under law.



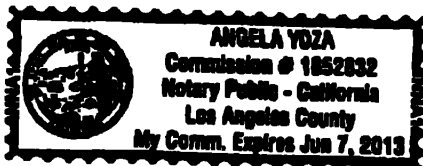
