Dear Counsel:

It is my belief that a number of violations of Federal Election Commission regulations have occurred. I would like to file a complaint against Clayton Bowler, whose address is Ozark, Missouri 65721, and Jacob Lawrence, whose address is PO BOX 1946, Nixa, MO 65714. Clayton Bowler has for several months operated an un-registered Federal PAC named "Long is Wrong." As of May 25, 2010 Clayton Bowler announced his retirement from blogging, and his blogs were taken over by Jacob Lawrence (as a caveat to Jacob's involvement, neither party has made it clear who is now administering the PAC). Some time ago, I believe the Long is Wrong PAC exceeded the \$1,000 threshold of contributions or expenditures that requires FEC registration, yet it has not registered with the FEC. Were it to register with the FEC I believe that would trigger a series of other violations related to its conduct, and this letter represents my best efforts to document the violations.

Overview

*(Note: Attached to this letter is documentation on any prices referenced in this letter and records of blog posts, which were accessed on or before May 27, 2010.)*

Total expenditures for the Long is Wrong PAC (<http://longiswrong.blogspot.com/>) are far in excess of the \$1,000 threshold that triggers mandatory registration with the Federal Election Commission. It would not be unreasonable to assert that the PAC has expended more than \$4,000 through spending on newsletter, web site and campaigning at events. The Long is Wrong PAC has a vested interest in concealing the full extent of its expenditures: by acknowledging that it has passed the threshold, it would trigger a cascade of ethics violations and costly fines.

These violations include the illegal use of a candidate's name in a non-connected PAC, a failure to collect necessary information on donors via its online PayPal contribution system and open coordination with numerous campaigns in the 7<sup>th</sup> Congressional District (which are extensively documented throughout his blog in conversations with the candidates, reprinting of campaign press releases, and other associations). Additional issues might be raised with the lack of a 'paid for by' on any of the collateral or signage produced to date by the PAC. The PAC has also misled donors by promising and then failing to register with the FEC: this can only be construed as a deliberate maneuver to deny donors

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transparency in how their money is being spent and the comfort of knowing that it complies with the legal standards laid down by the FEC.

Circumstances suggest that Clayton Bowler may also be using the PAC and its contributors for personal profit: while the PAC collects donations to pay for collateral, it also sells its collateral. Because these aspects of its operation don't represent a drain on its finances, the only possible source for expenditures is on Clayton Bowler himself. Only by registering with the FEC could the legally mandated transparency requirements lay rest to this possibility.

### Collateral/Signage

**Design Costs:** Unknown, but designs have been produced for at least five pieces of collateral listed below.

**Banner:** \$38.21 for one vinyl banner, size 3'x8' from the vendor (BuildASign) advertised on the Long is Wrong blog.

**T-Shirt:** Quantity unknown. One T-Shirt was offered as a prize on March 18, with an advertised value of \$20.95. No winner was announced.

**Bumper Stickers:** Quantity unknown. Pricing is \$2.99 for a quantity of 1, \$48.00 for a quantity of 25. Long is Wrong has announced that it has made at least two orders of bumper stickers.

**Bumper Magnets:** Quantity unknown. Pricing is \$11.86 for a quantity of one, \$97.50 for a quantity of 25. The Long is Wrong blog advertised their intent on April 22.

**Yard Signs:** Quantity unknown. Pricing for an 18"x24" sign begins at \$40.38 for one sign, \$312.40 for 20 signs. On March 6, the Long is Wrong blog announced that it would be unveiling multiple yard sign designs and their pricing, but no details have been forthcoming.

### Web Site and Blogging

**Domain Registration:** \$7.99 through Netfirms, domain privacy settings included.

**Blogging:** Clayton Bowler has completed 159 posts on the Long is Wrong blog. Estimating the value of his time at \$20/hr, and assuming that it takes half an hour to research and write a blog post, the cost for his professional services would be \$1,590. He has also written in excess of 100 posts connected to Billy Long and the Long is Wrong PAC on sister-blog Bungalow Bill's Conservative Wisdom (<http://bungalowbillncw.blogspot.com/>), many of which are unique (as opposed to identical articles posted on both blogs). The additional blog posts increase the total to a hypothetical \$2,590. If Clayton Bowler were compensated according to Missouri's minimum wage, which may be a more reasonable assessment of his professional earning potential, the total would still be a significant \$938.88.

### Travel Expenses

**Costs:** Vehicle is a PT Cruiser, 22 MPG combined mileage. Gas prices in Ozark, Missouri (as of today's date) are roughly \$2.59 per gallon. Ignoring wear and tear on the vehicle, the cost of gas alone is \$.12 per mile. Alternately, the government rate established by the GSA for privately owned vehicle mileage reimbursement as of January 1, 2010 is \$.50/mile.

Gas: \$.12/mile @ 534.04 miles = \$64.08

GSA Compensation: \$.50/mile @ 534.04 miles = \$267.02

Time Driving: \$20/hr @ 10.266 hours = \$205.32

Time Campaigning At Events (assuming 1.5 hours per event): \$20/hr @ 15 hours = \$300

Estimated entrance fees for Lincoln Days Events: \$100

### **Total Possible Costs**

**Collateral:** Assuming that Long is Wrong has ordered one 3'x8' vinyl banner, 5 t-shirts, 25 bumper stickers, 25 bumper magnets and 20 yard signs, total collateral costs are \$597.86. Adding a nominal fee of \$50 for design work brings the total to \$647.86. It is probable that this number is much higher: marginal cost reductions in ordering higher quantities of collateral makes it more efficient to spend a larger amount rather than repeat small orders over and over again.

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**Blogging:** The costs of registering a domain for a web site and researching and drafting 259 blog posts totals \$2,597.99 (a relatively low amount, at only \$10 per blog post). This may be an optimistic assessment of Clayton Bowler's earning potential, given his status as a recent college graduate and amateur writer. Even if he were paid minimum wage, he would still earn \$246.87.

**Travel:** Associated costs with attending events and vehicle reimbursement, as established by GSA rates (which are designed to cover the entire cost of vehicle use) totals \$872.34.

**Overall:** A reasonable estimate for total expenditures by the Long is Wrong PAC is \$4,067.86, more than four times the threshold for mandatory registration with the FEC. Some elements of this estimate may be overstated, but it is more likely that they have been understated. Given the substantial level of activity within the Long is Wrong PAC it is unreasonable to believe that they have received contributions or made expenditures of an amount less than \$1,000.

The PAC's status might be considered when assessing (1) that Clayton Bowler has advertised and solicited funds under the name of a PAC that does not exist, and by failing to fulfill his promise to register with the FEC he has misled his donors (2) the absence of donor information collection for contributions solicited via Paypal on his blog (3) the illegal use of a candidate's name in a nonconnected PAC (4) the PAC's open coordination with political campaigns and campaign staff in its blogging activities (5) the PAC's failure to place mandatory 'paid for by' disclosures on its collateral.

Democrat? Tim Davis for Congress,  
Missouri's Seventh Congressional District

I met Tim Davis just after he completed a high school Bible study at James River Assembly in Clark this evening. I had spoken to Mr. Davis on a number of occasions and had the pleasure of meeting him at the Clark Chamber of Commerce Congressional forum last Friday night. We continued the conversation we started that night.



After the forum, I heard it said many times, is Tim sure he's a Democrat. Seriously, he comes across as more conservative than Billy Long and Darrell Moore, and I geared the conversation to see just how conservative Mr. Davis is. So we started on the issue of why Mr. Davis calls himself a Democrat.

He says historically, he has not carried a party affiliation. He has never voted straight across party lines: His friendship with Missouri Democratic Party chairman Craig Haemer had more to his decision to pick a side. He also says he has been disappointed in the Republican party because they forgot why they went to Washington. More important: I don't trust them to look after the interests of Southwest Missouri. Of course that brings up an interesting question, based on faith and his staunch pro-life church, how does one join a Democratic party that shows a reluctant side when it comes to protecting abortion rights.

For most of Southwest Missouri, Davis argues abortion isn't an issue. This is a staunch pro-life area of the country, and Democrats and Republicans alike support life. I asked Mr. Davis if he thinks he can lead the Democratic party to a more pro-life stance. He believes he is just one guy who will do the best he can, and says he was up front with the Democratic party about his pro-life views.

He quickly explains Democrats in Southwest Missouri worry about the growing deficit. I find this perplexing to think about considering the huge spending across in Congress since Democrats took over the legislative branch in 2007.

Davis is probably the strongest candidate in the race in economic theory followed by Jeff Wadsworth. In fact, you could go as far as saying he wrote the book, *Ricardo's Microeconomics*. David Ricardo was a 19th century economist that pulled Britain out of a period of inflation, industrial unemployment, and jobs lost abroad. Davis wrote his book based on applying Ricardo's principles to America today, and believes his theory is capable of saving the American economy, which is one of the reasons he chose to run.

Davis says you can't point a finger to one single factor that has forced the economy into trouble. He then explains how one of the problems is the aging population and the stress it places on Social Security. For an Oxford PhD, Davis is patient in explaining economic principles.

He says the problem with Social Security comes from the fact the work force is not large enough to support the system which has more demands placed on it as Baby Boomers retire. To save it, Davis jumps across the anti-business, anti-industry part of his party over to the other side and says taxes need to be cut in order to produce jobs. He believes non-wage taxes need to be lowered to attract capital and entrepreneurial ability. This includes corporate tax rates need to be lowered, as well as other non-wage taxes like capital gains and interest taxes.

Joe Cases, Chad Livingston, and a news man from KITS gathered together to ask seven of the candidates running for Congress in Missouri's Seventh Congressional District. Bob Schanz was going to announce his decision not to continue running for the seat wasn't allowed a microphone prior to the forum.

The first question was on illegal immigration. What scenario is many of the men running don't understand passus... which prevents federal troops from patrolling US soil for civilian law enforcement. I felt Michael Wadell, Jeff Wisdom, and Mike Moon were the strongest on illegal immigration.

Wadell: Illegal immigration steals jobs from those who need the work. Our border security is lacking, and allows the immigrants to pass the border unchecked. We can't continue this process.

Obviously, with jobs as a concern for most Americans, Wadell raised the practical answer. Nodler, R-Py Long, and Goodman support putting federal troops on the border, which I would consider a violation of posse comitatus.

Wisdom got the military solution right, claiming the National Guard should be used. Right on, right co. The last thing we want in Obama's America is federal troops patrolling our cities.

Moon: Borders - we should employ the state patrol. They could also increase illegals, want them 80-90 dollars per head. Moon also made up for his statement in Lawrence County which was not meant, claiming there wasn't an illegal immigration problem. He will think twice before talking to Barry Pitt the next time about issues.

The loser on this question was Darrell Moore, who wasn't sounding too conservative to me. Moore said, "we need to increase our foreign aid to bring jobs to Latin America." Hey Mr. Moore, spending \$787 billion in American didn't create too many jobs in the past year and got us further into debt. Do you really think it would work in Mexico, where it's far more corrupt without any check and balance.

The second question had way about party unity. Even though today's event was mostly a love fest of grateful Republicans thanks to Leigh Anne Gerren's ruling, which presented some forms of free political speech. How do you keep party unity? (Like I said, it was a love fest.)

Mike Moon, who delivered the most jaw of the day said, "we have to avoid taking cheap shots." He would put Billy Long in his place later in the event drawing applause, and then a few at Nodler as well. While Billy may consider it cheap, Moon's timing was perfect.

Wadell enforced Wisdom's effort, which of course is one of the problems in going after someone. "As a party, we have lost our way. We believe in small government - states rights, and I believe in some federal, we have lost our way. Once we get back to our values - the bleeding goes away."

Billy Long, who faces possible FEC election violations related to attempting to bribe a journalist and possible corporate campaign violations, had one of the weakest answers because it doesn't take into account Long is a wounded candidate with a huge cash lead that may still pull this off for the nomination. Long said, "The democrats are

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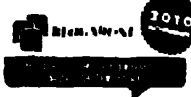
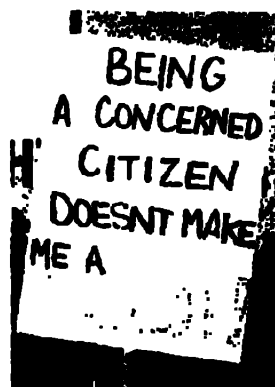
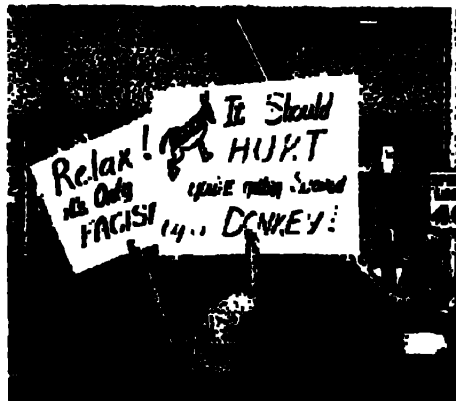

With five months to the primaries and Lincoln Day event to go, I feel like we have regressed in Missouri's Seventh District.
