

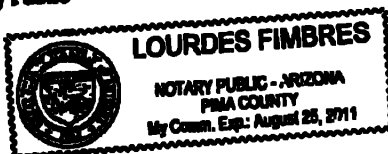
On the next page is a screen capture I made on 1/16/2010 of the front page of Levin's web site for his radio show that shows the link to the Brown campaign.
